Typhoon Halong: West Coast Storm *See Attachments

Recovery efforts proceeded along the western coast. The State and FEMA Joint Command initiated coordinated operations, while the Disaster Housing Task Force advanced plans to move evacuees from congregate shelters into non-congregate housing.

Individuals evacuated from Western Alaska due to the October 2025 West Coast Storm who needed sheltering assistance are directed to call the Non-Congregate Shelter Assistance Line at: **907-759-6927** (Monday–Saturday, 9:00 a.m.–6:00 p.m.)

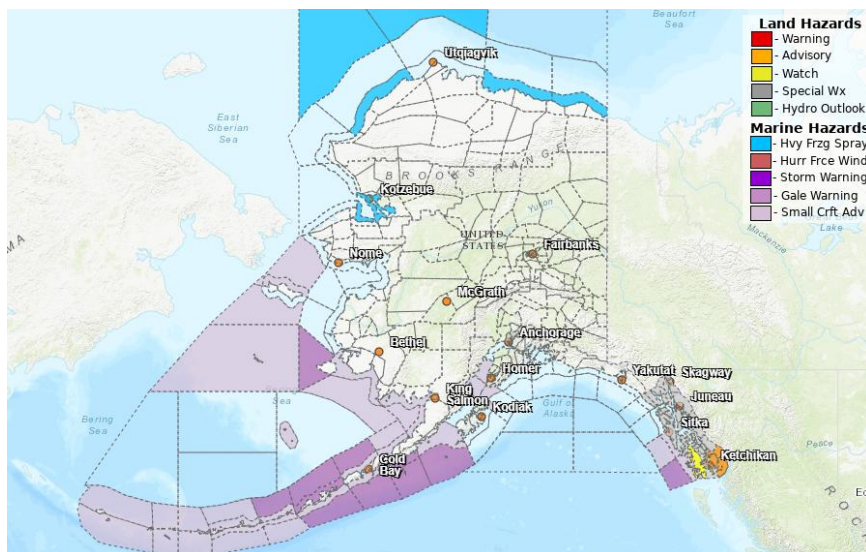
