Significant Issues:

Typhoon Halong: West Coast Storm:

Ongoing transition from response to recovery the State, FEMA, EMAC, and all partners continue to focus on disaster operations. Services for evacuees are available at the Spenard Community Recreation Center, including a Disaster Assistance Center (DAC). The facility is open daily from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. See the link in Public Information section below for additional details.

Emerging Incidents:

The SEOC was notified of a structure fire in Chevak that caused a power outage affecting several nearby homes. The State Fire Marshal's Office and AVEC were contacted. AVEC confirmed the issue is being addressed and that all necessary partners are informed. The SEOC remains ready to provide support as needed.

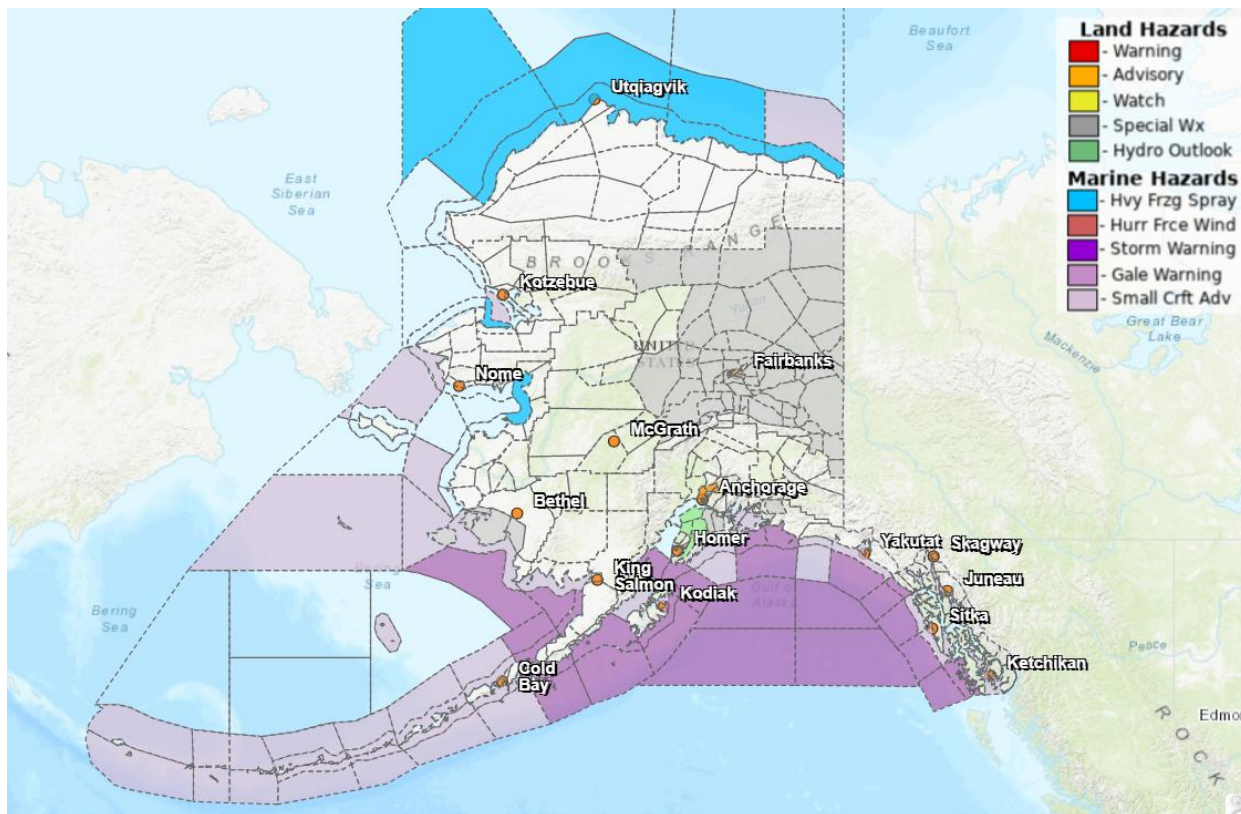
