**Typhoon Halong: West Coast Storm:** SEOC operations specialists are providing coordinated support to the Emergency Operations Center (EOC) and the Disaster Assistance Centers (DACs) in Bethel and Kotzebue to ensure the efficient continuation of response and recovery operations. Additionally, a Disaster Assistance Center is operating at the Calista Corporation Building, 1400 W. Benson Blvd., Suite 110-155, Anchorage, AK, and will remain open through November 14.

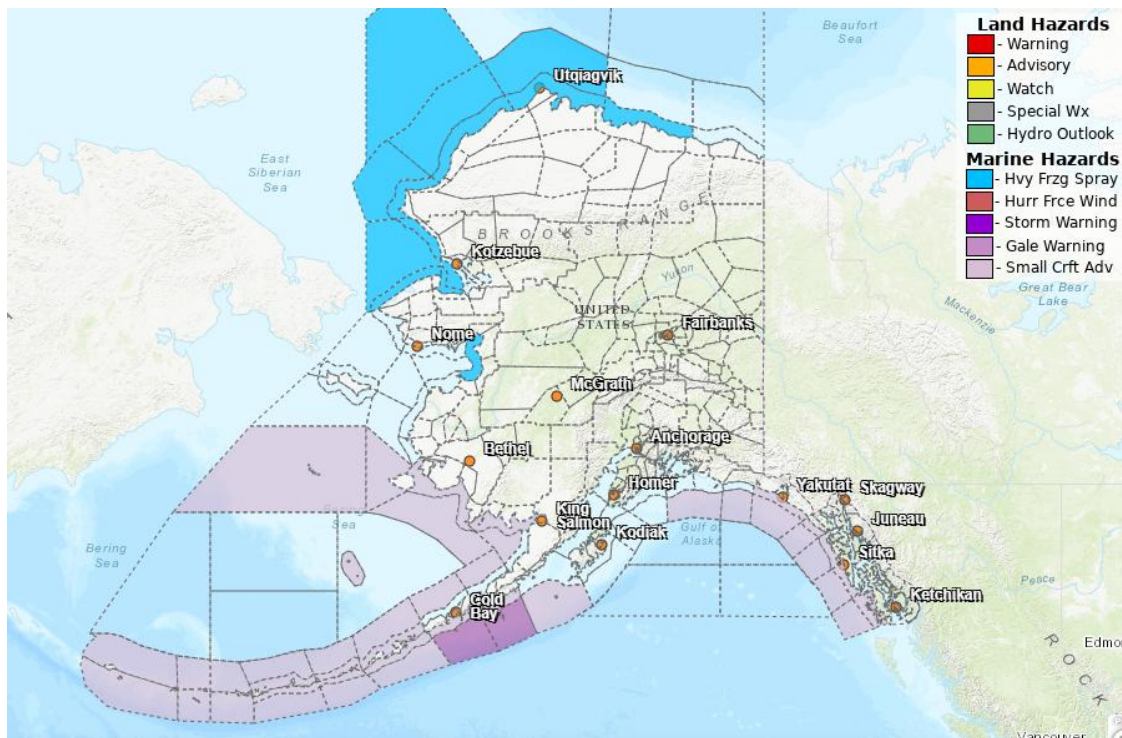
