Significant Issues: Typhoon Halong: West Coast Storm

Mail pick-up services will continue at the Egan Center through the end of November. Bethel DAC continues through Friday, November 21st. Div Sup for Branch 1- Kotzebue completed Kivalina disaster assistance visit over the weekend and demobilized from the Northwest Arctic Borough. Operational briefings transitioned to Tuesday's and Thursdays.

Emerging Incidents: Seward Peninsula Winter Storm

The National Weather Service has advised the SEOC of a strong winter storm expected to bring heavy snow, strong winds, and blizzard conditions to communities across the Seward Peninsula over the next several days.

The SEOC contacted communities in the affected area, along with regional leadership, to confirm awareness of the forecast and verify preparedness actions. Concerns regarding the potential for moderate high water in Hooper Bay have been reduced based on the latest forecast update.

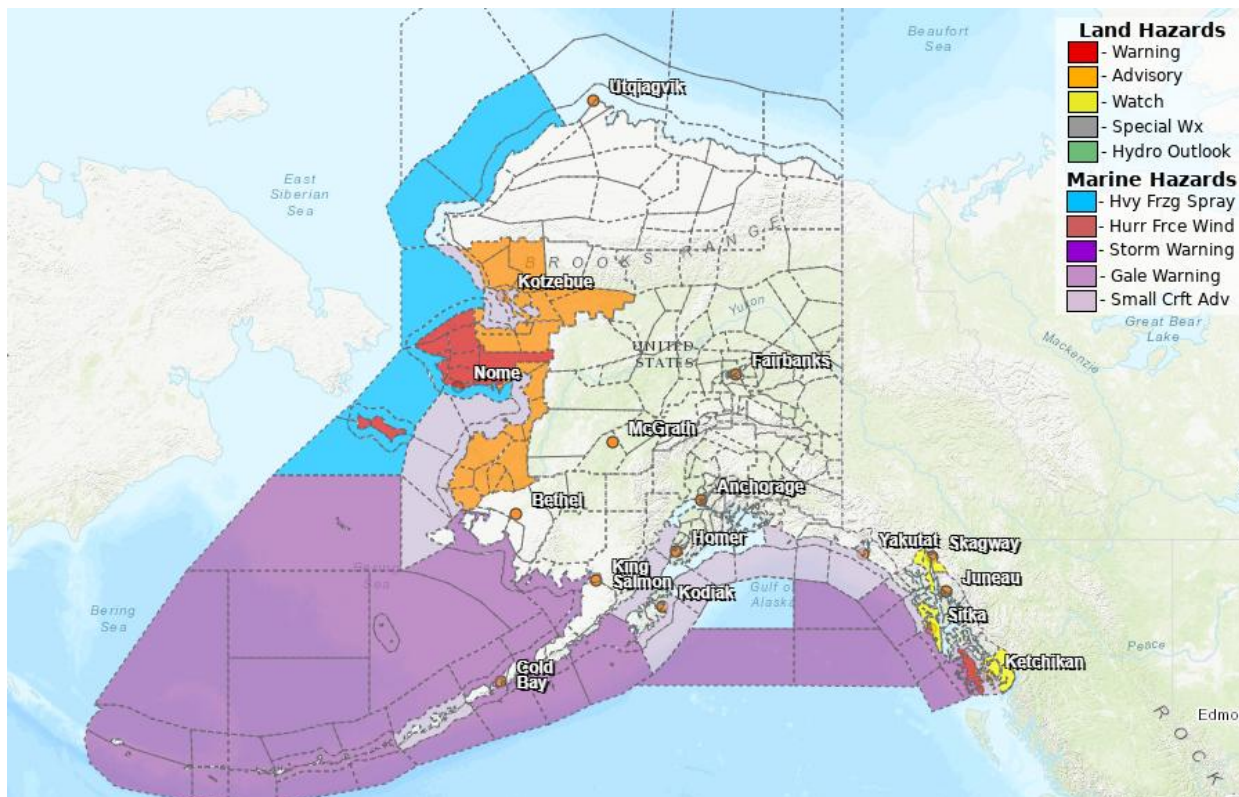

Winter Storm Warning: Southern Seward Peninsula Coast; Interior Seward Peninsula, Shishmaref, Bering Strait Coast and St. Lawrence Island - Now in effect until 6 PM Thursday.

Winter Storm Watch: Haines Borough and Klukwan – Starting Wednesday Morning Through Wednesday Evening.

Winter Weather Advisory: Noatak Valley; Kivalina and Red Dog Dock; Lower Kobuk Valley; Baldwin Peninsula; Northern Seward Peninsula; Upper Kobuk Valleys, Eastern Norton Sound and Nulato Hills; Yukon Delta Coast and Lower Yukon River – Winter Weather Advisory in effect until 6 PM Thursday.

High Wind Watch: City and Borough of Sitka- In effect from late tonight through Wednesday evening.

High Wind Warning: Prince of Wales Island - High Wind Warning in effect from 6 AM to 6 PM Wednesday.
