Recovery operations remain underway, with emergency repair activities transitioning to winter-appropriate work as field crews begin demobilization. Operational briefings have shifted to a Tuesday and Friday schedule for this week. The Bethel Disaster Assistance Center will continue to operate through Friday, November 21.

No major impacts reported, warnings extended through Wednesday, but concern for any serious Hopper Bay inundation has decreased.

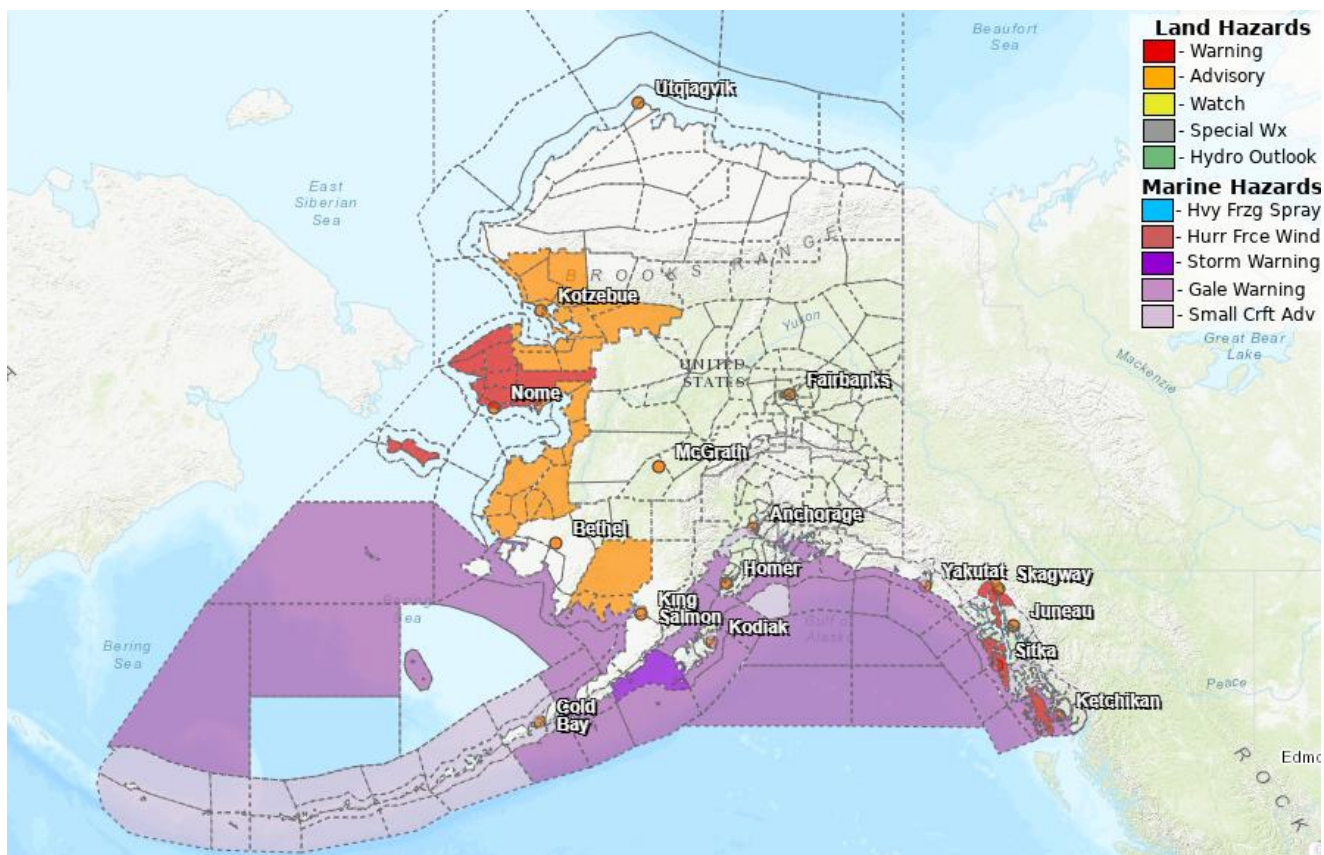

Dense Fog Advisory: Anchorage – In effect until 11 AM AKST this morning.

High Wind Warning: City and Borough of Sitka; Prince of Wales Island – Remains in effect through this afternoon and evening Sitka until 3 PM; Prince of Wales Island until 6 PM.

Winter Storm Warning: Southern Seward Peninsula Coast; Interior Seward Peninsula; Shishmaref; Bering Strait Coast; St. Lawrence Island; Haines Borough and Klukwan – Remains in effect until 6 AM to 6 PM Thursday Haines Borough/Klukwan until 6 PM today; all others until 6 AM Thursday.

Winter Weather Advisory: Municipality of Skagway; Northern Bristol Bay Coast; Inland Bristol Bay; Eastern Norton Sound and Nulato Hills; Yukon Delta Coast; Lower Yukon River; Noatak Valley; Kivalina and Red Dog Dock; Lower Kobuk Valley; Baldwin Peninsula; Northern Seward Peninsula; Upper Kobuk Valleys – Remains in effect with varying end times Skagway from noon today to 6 AM Thursday; all Western Alaska advisory zones through 6 AM Thursday; Bristol Bay zones from 6 PM this evening to 6 PM Thursday.
