

#### **WARNINGS:**

Extreme Cold Warning - Municipality of Skagway: Remains in effect until noon AKST Sunday.

**Haines Borough and Klukwan:** Remains in effect from midnight Saturday night to noon AKST Sunday.

#### **WATCHES:**

**High Wind Watch –** City and Borough of Juneau: Remains in effect from Saturday evening through late Sunday night.

# **ADVISORIES:**

**Winter Weather Advisory –** Eastern Beaufort Sea Coast: Remains in effect until 6 AM AKST Saturday.

**Cold Weather Advisory – Haines Borough and Klukwan:** Remains in effect until midnight AKST Saturday night.

Western Kupreanof and Kuiu Island; City and Borough of Wrangell: Remains in effect from midnight tonight to noon AKST Sunday.

City of Hyder: Remains in effect from 6 PM this evening to noon AKST Sunday.

Glacier Bay; Cape Fairweather to Lisianski Strait: Remains in effect until noon AKST Sunday.



Turnagain Pass and Girdwood – Moderate above 2,500; Moderate above 1,000; Low below tree line.

**Summit Lake – Moderate** above 2,500; **Moderate** between 1,000-2,500; **Low** below 1,000. **Seward and Lost Lake** – Early season conditions persist; forecasts will be issued when coverage improves.

**Valdez Maritime, Intermountain, and Continental** – Beware wind slabs, forecast discussion available <u>here</u>. (from 12/20)
