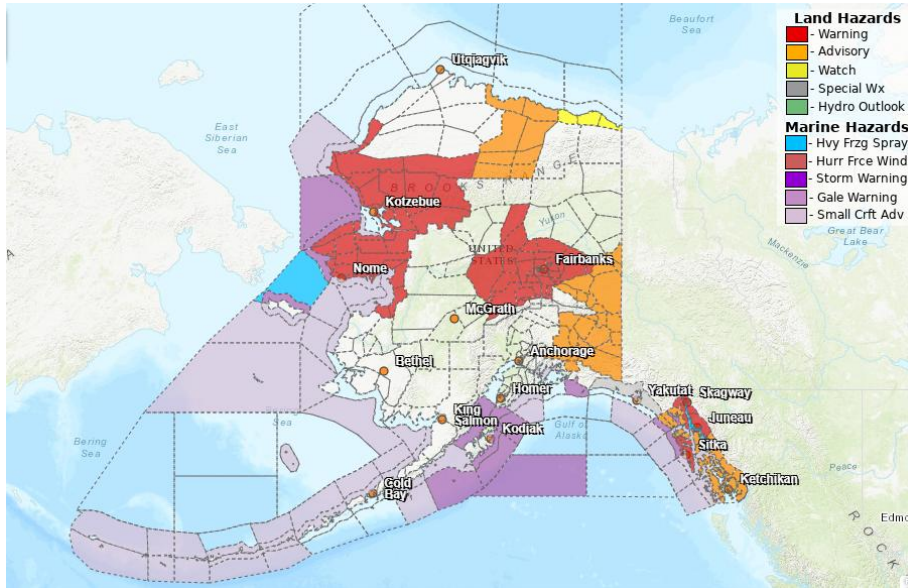

Winter Storm Warning – Dalton Highway Summits; Tanana Flats; Eielson AFB and Salcha; Goldstream Valley and Nenana Hills; Chatanika River Valley; Two Rivers; Fairbanks Metro Area; Nenana; Central Interior; Northern Denali Borough: Remains in effect from 6 PM Tuesday to 9 AM AKST Thursday.

Shishmaref; Bering Strait Coast; Southern Seward Peninsula Coast; Interior Seward Peninsula; Eastern Norton Sound and Nulato Hills; South Slopes of the Western Brooks Range; Noatak Valley; Kivalina and Red Dog Dock; Lower Kobuk Valley; Baldwin Peninsula; Northern Seward Peninsula; Upper Kobuk Valleys; Western Arctic Coast; Howard Pass and the Delong Mountains: Remains in effect through 9 AM AKST Wednesday.

Summit Lake – Moderate above 2,500; Low below 2,500’.

Hatcher Pass – Low above 2500’.

Seward and Lost Lake – Early season conditions still exist in the Seward and Lost Lake zone.
