2025 Riverwatch Operations:

Lower Yukon Division - Based in Bethel

The Division Supervisor relocated from Galena to Bethel on Saturday. Sunday, she flew a portion of the lower Yukon River from north of Holy Cross down to Marshall, checking on ice conditions. Most of the section was found open or had rotting ice sheets in place. No issues were reported. The plan for today is to monitor the weather closely and potentially fly later in the afternoon or evening, if weather clears.


