## 2025 Riverwatch Operations:

Lower Yukon Division - Based in Bethel

The Division Supervisor flew from Bethel for several hours yesterday. She was able to observe conditions over Russian Mission, Grayling, Anvik, Holy Cross and Kaltag. Most areas of the river are clear of ice or have broken ice moving slowly. The National Weather Service team members arrive this morning. The team plans to fly this afternoon once weather has cleared the area. No issues have been reported.

**Upper Yukon Division –** Based in Fairbanks Demobilized Friday.




