Significant Issues:

Quinhagak:

State assistance and DEC are actively coordinating with the City and Tribal leadership to assess ongoing power and water system issues and determine appropriate technical support and next steps.

St. Michael:

DEC and State partners are coordinating with local operators to address the frozen sewer discharge line and vacuum system failure. Technical assistance is underway, and continued coordination is in progress to restore services and assess additional needs.


