Significant Issues:

Aniak School Roof Concern

SEOC received notice that a portion of the high school roof was at risk of imminent failure. Engineers are doing assessments regarding the potential cause. SEOC and partner agencies will provide support as community and school officials determine safety measures and next steps. Students have been moved to another location to continue their educational studies. SEOC will continue to monitor this event.

2025 October West Coast Storm Disaster:

- 68 households/199 individuals transitioned from non-congregate shelters (hotels) to longer-term housing (apartments)



Significant Weather:





Dense Fog Advisory in effect for East Turnagain Arm from south of Potter Marsh to Portage, including Girdwood, until 10am this morning.

Turnagain Pass and Girdwood – Considerable at all elevations

Summit Lake - Considerable at all elevations

Seward and Lost Lake- Considerable at all elevations

Maritime – Considerable at elevations from 1500 to 3000ft, Moderate at above 3000ft

Intermountain – Considerable at elevations between 2000 to 4000ft, Moderate above 4000ft

Continental – Considerable at elevations above 2000ft
