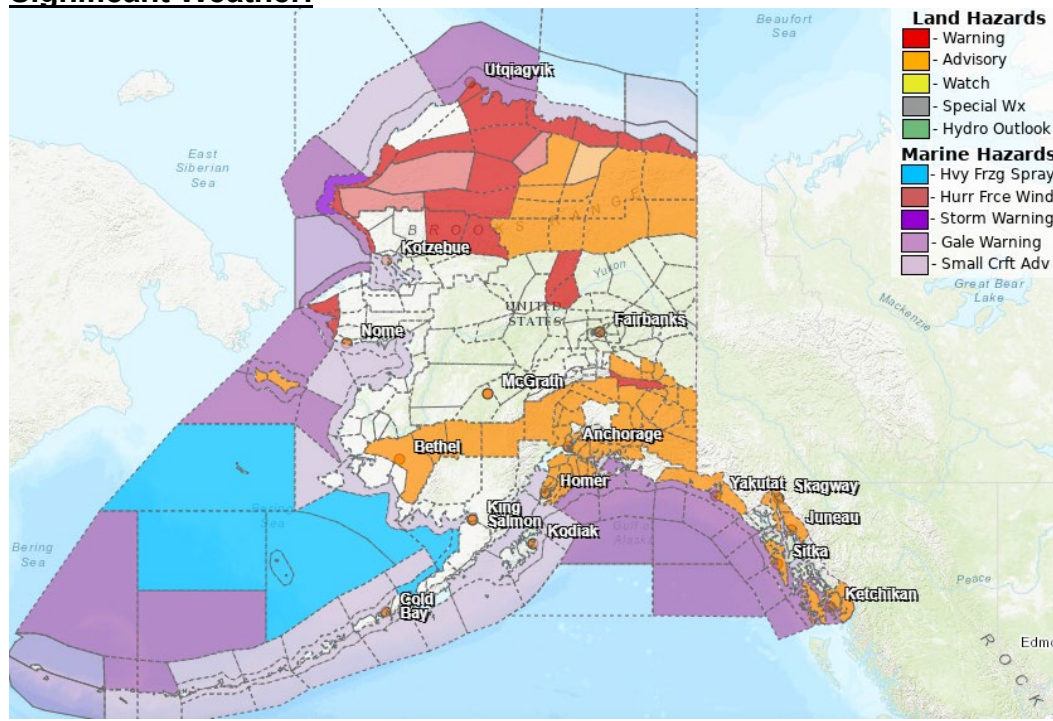

Extreme Cold Weather Warning:

- Western Arctic plains, Howard Pass and the Delong Mountains-until 3pm Wednesday.
- Arctic Coast until 9am Wednesday.

Cold Weather Advisory:

- Dalton Highway-until noon today.
- South Slope of the Eastern and Central Brooks Range, Romanzof Mountains until 3pm today.
- Kuskokwim Valley-until 9am Thursday.

Blizzard Warning:

- Kivalina and Red Dog Dock, Bering Strait Coast- until 3 pm today.
- Arctic Coast- until noon today.

Winter Weather Advisory:

- Southcentral- snow accumulations up to 4-8 inches in effect until 9pm this evening.

Special Weather Statement-

- Pribilof Islands- snow showers, blowing snow, and reduces visibility through Wednesday morning.

Turnagain Pass and Girdwood – Considerable at elevations above 1000ft, Moderate below 1000ft

Summit Lake - Considerable at elevations above 1000ft, Moderate below 1000ft

Seward and Lost Lake- Considerable at elevations above 1000ft, Moderate below 1000ft

Maritime – Moderate at elevations from 1500 and above, Low below 1500ft

Intermountain – Moderate at elevations from 1500 and above, Low below 1500ft

Continental – Considerable at elevations above 2000ft. low below 2,000ft
