Significant Issues:

The SEOC continues to gather information about the status of water generation in Shungnak from DEC and Northwest Arctic Borough. A Boil Water Notice (BWN) was issued Jan 21 for part of the village, with this now being expanded to a system wide BWN. Crews continue to work to thaw frozen portions of the system.

2025 October West Coast Storm Disaster:

- 108 households/340 individuals transitioned from non-congregate shelters (hotels) to longer-term housing (apartments)
- In Non-Congregate Shelter (hotels) Individuals: 340, Households: 65



Blizzard Warning in effect:

- Western Arctic Coast
- Yukon Delta Coast; Lower Yukon River; St Lawrence Island
- Kuskokwim Delta Coast and Nunivak Island; Interior Kuskokwim Delta

Winter Storm Warning:

- Eastern Norton Sound and Nulato Hills, Interior Seward Peninsula, Lower Koyukuk Valley, Lower Yukon and Innoko Valleys, Middle Yukon Valley, North Slopes of the Western Alaska Range, Southern Seward Peninsula Coast, and Upper Kuskokwim Valley.

Winter Storm Watch:

- Central Interior, Chatanika River Valley, Eielson AFB and Salcha, Fairbanks Metro Area, Goldstream Valley and Nenana Hills, Nenana, Northern Denali Borough, Tanana Flats, Two Rivers, Upper Chena River Valley, and White Mountains and High Terrain South of the Yukon River


Winter Weather Advisory in effect:

- Central Arctic Plains, Central Beaufort Sea Coast, Eastern Beaufort Sea Coast, Northern Arctic Coast, Northwest Arctic Coast, and Western Arctic Plains.
- Baldwin Peninsula, Bering Strait Coast, Kivalina and Red Dog Dock, Lower Kobuk Valley, Noatak Valley, Northern Seward Peninsula, and Shishmaref.
- Kuskokwim Valley West
- Bristol Bay Borough (Naknek and King Salmon), Inland Bristol Bay, Lake Iliamna, Nila Vena, Nanvrapak, Northern Bristol Bay Coast, and Western Capes.

Cold Weather Advisory in effect:

- Arctic Coast, Arctic Plains, and Brooks Range Passes.

Avalanche Conditions:

Hatcher Pass – Moderate above 3500'; Moderate above 2500'; Low below 2500'

Turnagain Pass and Girdwood – Moderate above 2500'; Low below 2500' and treeline.

Summit Lake – Moderate above 2500'; Low below 2500' and treeline.

Seward and Lost Lake – Moderate above 2500'; Low below 2500' and treeline

Maritime – Considerable above 3000'; Considerable above 1500'; Moderate below 1500'

Intermountain – Considerable at all levels.

Continental – Considerable at all levels.
