Significant Issues:

SEOC was made aware of flooding issues at the Adak airport resulting from generator failure which normally supports the pump system. The Adak site operator, City of Adak, and TDX Power were all contacted. SEOC will continue to follow up and offer support.

2025 October West Coast Storm Disaster:

- 112 households/354 individuals transitioned from non-congregate shelters (hotels) to longer-term housing (apartments)



Avalanche Conditions:



Hatcher Pass – Moderate above 2500'; Low below 2500'.

Turnagain Pass and Girdwood – Moderate above 2500'; Low below 2500' and treeline.

Summit Lake – Moderate above 2500'; Low below 2500' and treeline.

Seward and Lost Lake – Moderate above 2500'; Low below 2500' and treeline

Maritime – Considerable above 1500' Moderate below 1500'.

Intermountain – Considerable above 2000' Moderate below 2000'.

Continental – Considerable above 1500' Moderate below 1500'.
