

St. Lawrence Island — Winter Storm Warning remains in effect until 3:00 PM AKST Monday.

Hatcher Pass – Moderate above 3500'; low below 3500'.

Turnagain Pass and Girdwood – Moderate above 2500'; Low below 2500' and treeline.

Summit Lake – Moderate 1000' to 2500'; Low below 1000' and treeline, Considerable above 2500'.

Seward and Lost Lake – Moderate above 2500'; Low below 2500 and treeline.

Maritime – Considerable at all levels.

Intermountain – Considerable at all levels.

Continental – Considerable at all levels.
