**Significant Issues:**

**Toksook Bay – Low Water Levels**

The community of Toksook Bay reported to the SEOC that the water storage tanks were reaching critical low levels due to equipment failure. Parts are on order and are expected to arrive and be installed in the next several weeks. SEOC is looking at options to supplement the water until the water tanks are up to full capacity.

**Selawik – Power Outage**

SEOC received a local declaration asking for State assistance yesterday afternoon. The main plant now has water circulating through the four lines with varying vacuums. The island plant's two lines are still frozen. Focus is on thawing the remaining lines. SEOC continues to monitor this event.

**Cold Bay – Power Issues**

The replacement transformer to restore power distribution to the City of Cold Bay was transferred from Anchorage to the community yesterday. Once the unit is prepped and installed, power is anticipated to be functional by the end of the day.

**2025 October West Coast Storm Disaster:**

- 122 households/396 individuals transitioned from non-congregate shelters (hotels) to longer-term housing (apartments)
- In Non-Congregate Shelter (hotels) Individuals: 246 Households: 46



**Winter Storm Warning is in effect for:**


