Significant Issues:

Juneau – Avalanche Advisory

CBJ is preparing for the potential need for evacuations due to elevated risk of avalanches. SEOC and Red Cross are aware of the situation and participated in a meeting with officials this afternoon regarding sheltering potential. Last night CBJ issued an avalanche advisory and put residents in known slide paths on “Set” on the “Ready, Set, Go” preparedness framework. SEOC continues to monitor the weather and is prepared to assist.

Gustavus -

SEOC received an inquiry from the community regarding the latest heavy snowfalls and whether the State is considering declaring snow removal aid. SEOC continues to monitor the weather throughout the state and will determine need.




