Significant Issues:

The City of Unalaska experienced significant damages following an impactful storm in late December 2025. As reported in this document yesterday, Governor Dunleavy has declared a disaster with activation of the Public Assistance program. Please see the attached press release for more information.

- 135 households/ 449 individuals transitioned from non-congregate shelters (hotels) to longer-term housing (apartments)
- In Non-Congregate Shelter (hotels) Individuals: 187 Households: 32



Significant Weather:




Special Weather Statement – Northern Seward Peninsula. Blowing snow and reduced visibility Friday with gusts over 35 mph at times.

Wind Advisory – Municipality of Skagway. Until 1PM this afternoon. NE winds 10-20 mph, gusts up to 40 mph.

Winter Weather Advisory – Prince of Wales Island and Ketchikan Gateway Borough. Until later this afternoon. Snow Expected, total snow accumulations of less than 5 inches.

Avalanche Conditions:



Hatcher Pass – Low at all aspects and elevations.

Chugach State Park – Considerable at all levels – from Sat 3/7.

Turnagain Pass and Girdwood – Moderate above 2500', low below 2,500' and treeline.

Summit Lake – Low at all aspects and elevations.

Seward and Lost Lake – Moderate above 2500', low below 2,500' and treeline.

Maritime, Intermountain, Continental – Moderate at all levels.

Haines area/Chiklat Pass – Moderate at treeline and above.

Douglas Island – Low at all levels – from Sun 3/8.

Juneau – Hazard decreasing, moving back to READY (down from SET)
