

**Hatcher Pass** – Low at all aspects and elevations.

**Chugach State Park** – Moderate above 1,000', low below 1,000'.

**Turnagain Pass and Girdwood** – Moderate above 2500', low below 2,500' and treeline.

**Summit Lake** – **Moderate above 2500', low below 2,500' and treeline**

**Seward and Lost Lake** – Moderate above 2500', low below 2,500' and treeline.

**Maritime, Intermountain, Continental** – Moderate at all levels.

**Haines area/Chiklat Pass** – Moderate above treeline.

**Douglas Island** – Moderate above treeline, low below.
