**Significant Issues:**

**Fort Yukon**

Yesterday, SEOC was made aware of homes in Fort Yukon that have frozen water and sewer lines, plus concern regarding water in the community's holding tank. The inquiry was originally made to the Governor's office by Fort Yukon's Tribal Administrator. SEOC reached out to the Administrator, ANTHC, DEC, the City and TCC. No current life safety issues were found, but the partners will continue to offer support to the residents in the affected homes.

**2025 October West Coast Storm Disaster:**

151 households/ 529 individuals transitioned from non-congregate shelters (hotels) to longer-term housing (apartments)

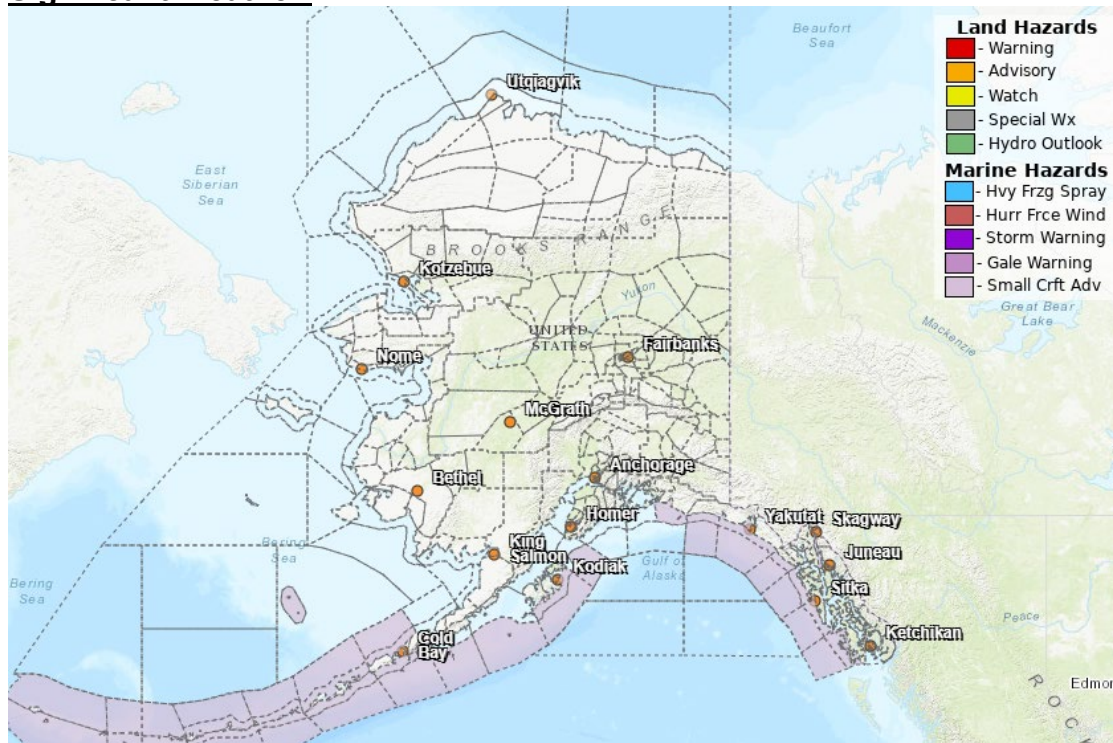
