Significant Issues:

Beaver Village Council shared a local disaster declaration with the SEOC late Friday afternoon. The community has frozen water due to a fuel shortage and very cold temperatures this past month. Tanana Chiefs Conference and SEOC are in contact with community leadership to identify life safety needs.

2025 October West Coast Storm Disaster:

151 households/ 529 individuals transitioned from non-congregate shelters (hotels) to longer-term housing (apartments)

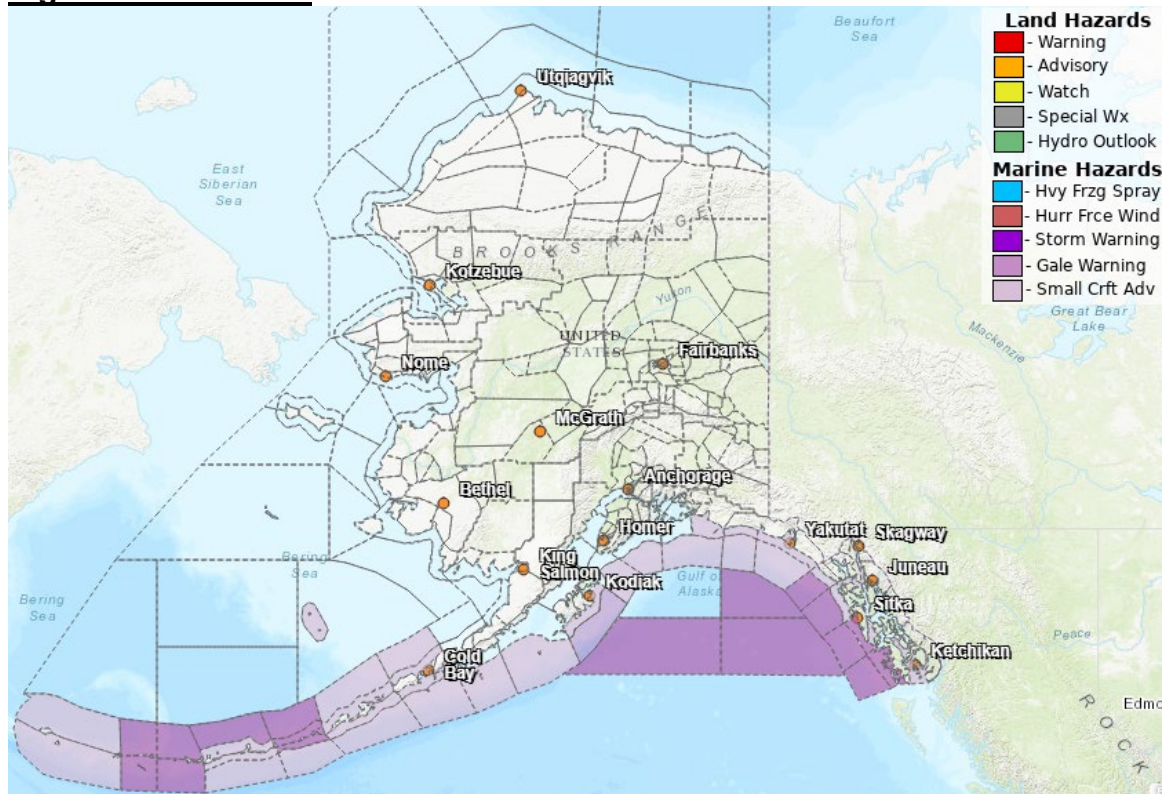
