Significant Issues:

Shaktolik Water Issues – SEOC was updated on current water pressure and freezing issues. Operations will continue to provide support.

Akiak Fuel – The City of Akiak updated SEOC on the current fuel shortage and has submitted requests for assistance to the state and outside organizations.

NWAB Utility Disaster – SEOC and DEC met with NWAB regarding implementation of the Governor’s disaster declaration. A Recovery Supervisor and Utility Specialist are in Kotzebue to assist the Borough.

2025 October West Coast Storm Disaster:

151 households/ 529 individuals transitioned from non-congregate shelters (hotels) to longer-term housing (apartments)

Barry Arm Landslide / Tsunami Risk:

The Barry Arm landslide currently shows no signs of large-scale active deformation but smaller-scale instabilities on the surface of the landslide still pose a threat of localized tsunami generation in Barry Arm. Mariners transiting near Barry Arm should remain vigilant.

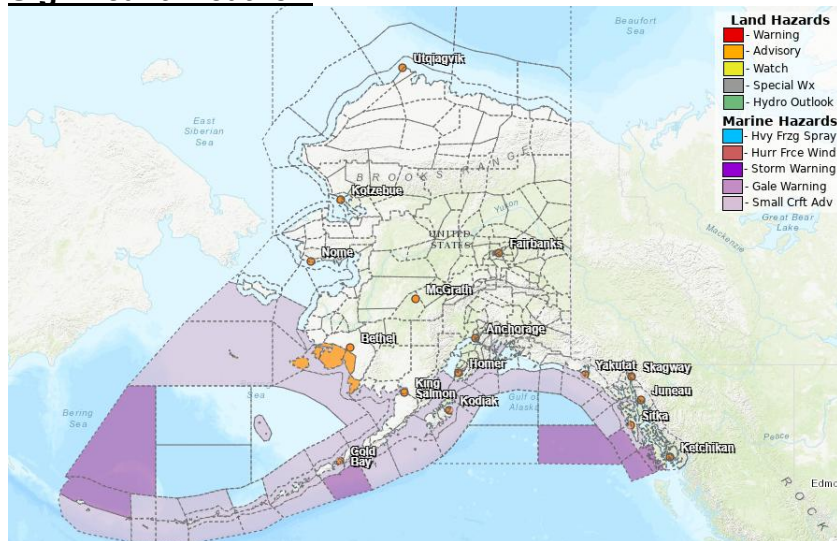
