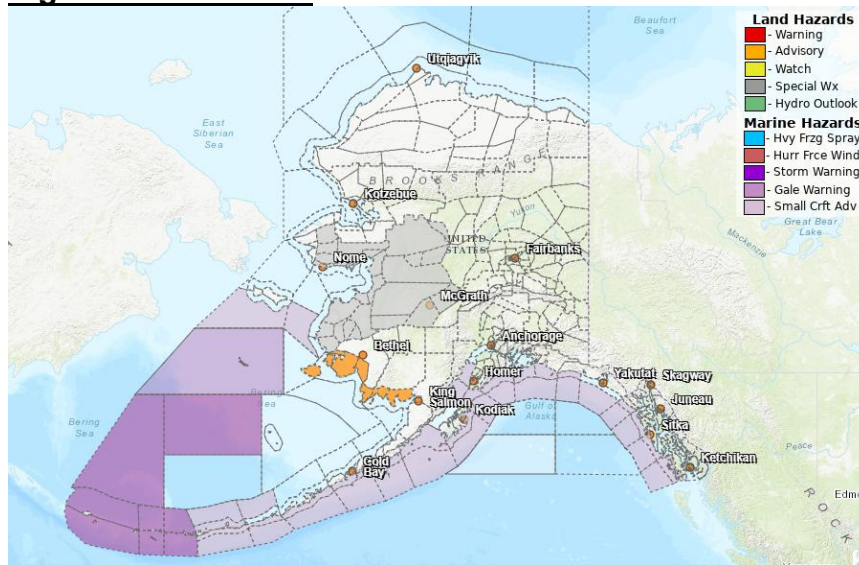

Winter Weather Advisory remains in effect until 10 AM AKDT this morning for Northern Bristol Bay Coast, Kuskokwim Delta Coast, Nunivak Island, and Western Capes.

ALERTS:

Special Weather Statement for Southern Seward Peninsula Coast, Interior Seward Peninsula, Eastern Norton Sound and Nulato Hills, Yukon Delta Coast, Lower Yukon River, Lower Koyukuk Valley, Middle Yukon Valley, Lower Yukon and Innoko Valleys, and Upper Kuskokwim Valley. Showery conditions bring periods of rain and snow.

Avalanche Conditions:



Hatcher Pass – Low at all elevations.

Chugach State Park – Considerable above 2500' Moderate below 2500'.

Turnagain Pass and Girdwood – Moderate above 2500' low below 2500'.

Summit Lake – Moderate above 2500' low below 2500'.

Seward and Lost Lake – Moderate above 2500' low below 2500'.

Valdez: Maritime, Intermountain, Continental – Moderate at all elevations.

Haines area/Chiklat Pass – Moderate above treeline.

Douglas Island – Low at all elevations.
