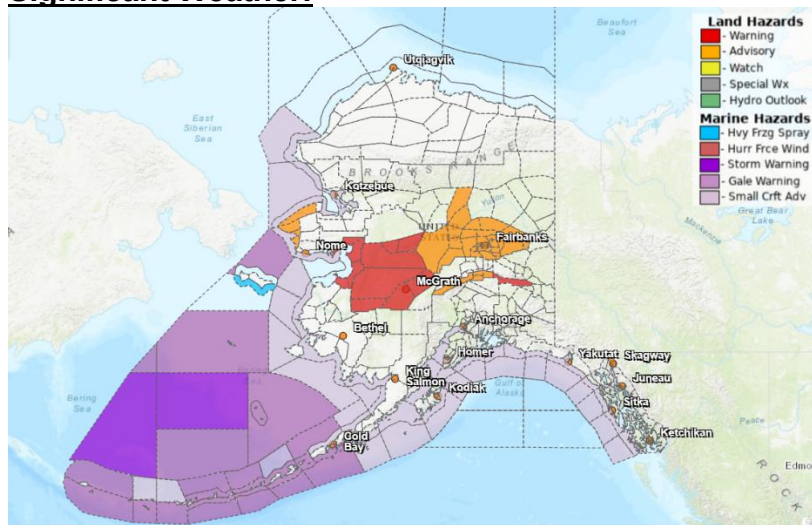

Avalanche Conditions:



Hatcher Pass – High Above 3500'. Considerable below 3500'.

Chugach State Park – High at all elevations.

Turnagain Pass and Girdwood – Considerable 2500' and above. Moderate Below 1000'.

Summit Lake – Considerable 1000' and above. Moderate Below 1000'.

Seward and Lost Lake – Considerable 1000' and above. Moderate Below 1000'.

Valdez: Maritime, Intermountain, Continental – Considerable at all elevations.

Douglas Island – Moderate at Upper Elevations. Low at lower elevations.
