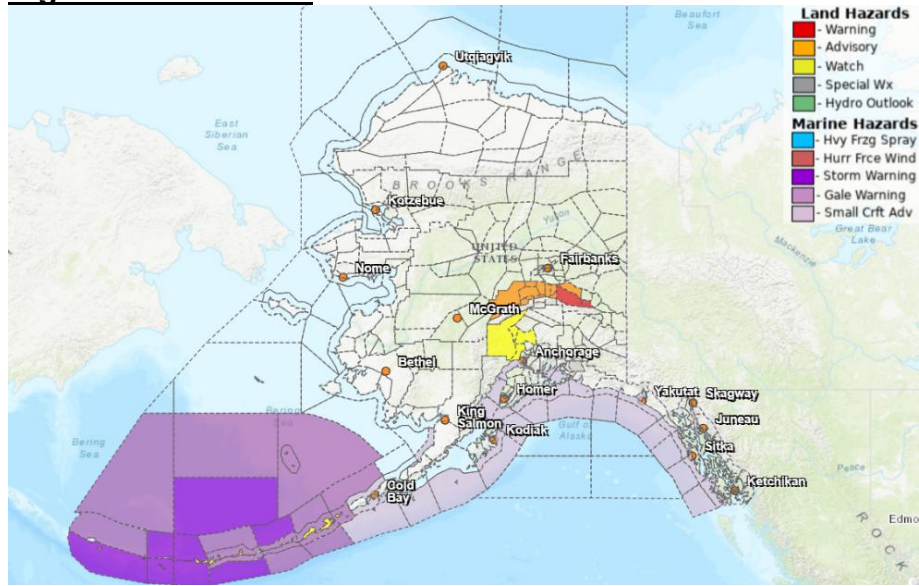

Seward and Lost Lake – Considerable at all elevations.

Valdez: Maritime, Intermountain, Continental – High at all elevations.

Douglas Island – Moderate at Upper Elevations. Low at middle and lower elevations.
