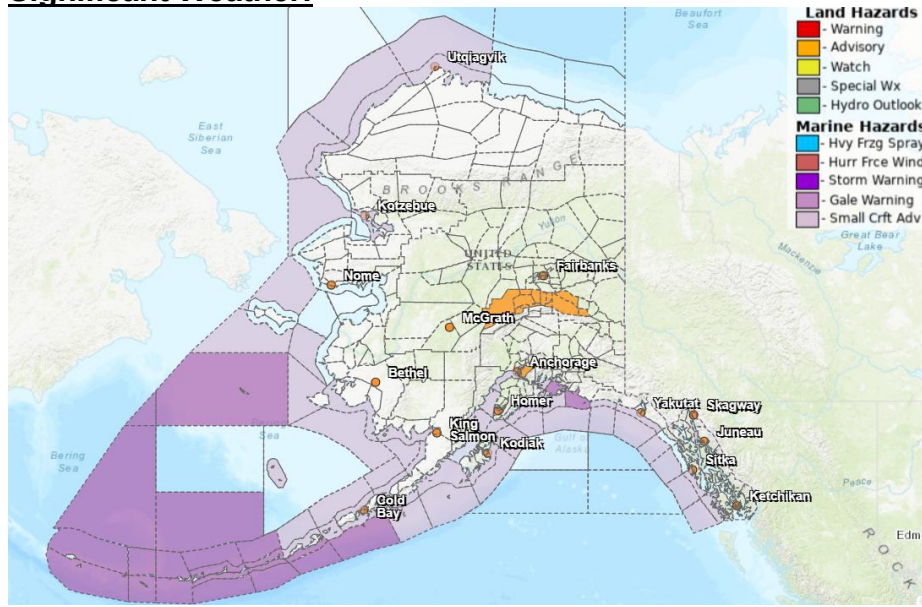

Hatcher Pass – Considerable above 1000, Moderate 1000' and under.

Chugach State Park – Considerable at all levels.

Turnagain Pass and Girdwood – Moderate at all levels.

Summit Lake – Considerable above 2500' Moderate below 2500'.

Seward and Lost Lake – Considerable above 2500' Moderate below 2500'.

Valdez: Maritime, Intermountain, Continental – Moderate at middle and upper elevations
Low at lower elevations.

Douglas Island – Moderate at Upper Elevations. Low at middle and lower elevations.
