**Significant Issues:**

The State demobilized the River Watch team today and downgraded the Preparedness Level back to 1.

DEC Stormwater Program contacted their point of contact in Chalkyitsik regarding impacts from recent flooding. The Village Council provided information to be forwarded to the DHS&EM Public Assistance team for support with debris removal and DEC remains engaged with the community and has provided technical assistance.

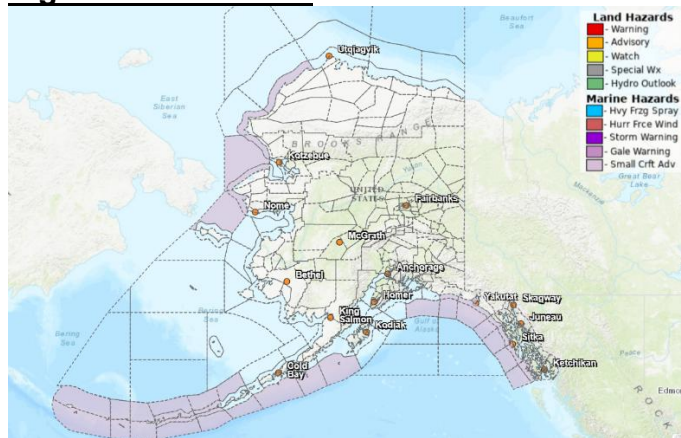

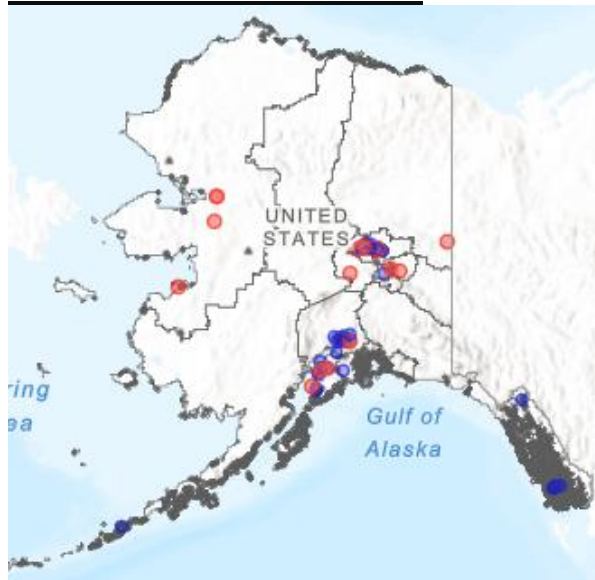
