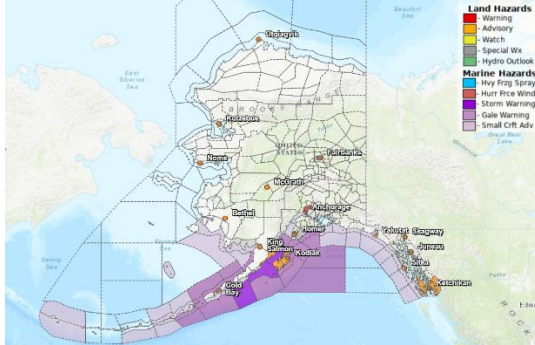

WARNINGS:
