Significant Issues:

Kopsheut Wildland Fire:

A wildfire that started Thursday afternoon at the Ambler landfill, approximately four miles from the community, had grown to an estimated 400 acres.

Twenty-four smokejumpers, supported by multiple aircraft, are actively engaged in suppression efforts, with additional firefighting resources ordered for today. Winds were pushing the fire and smoke toward the Kobuk River and away from Ambler.

Five homes, representing more than 30 residents, remained at risk overnight. Residents were prepared to shelter at the Ambler School or Tribal Hall if evacuations became necessary; however, no one sheltered last night.

The State Emergency Operations Center is coordinating with local officials. The Joint Tribal Council and City Council have issued a Fire Declaration under the community's existing emergency declaration, and emergency water supplies are being procured for the village.

The American Red Cross continues to monitor the situation and will provide support as needed.

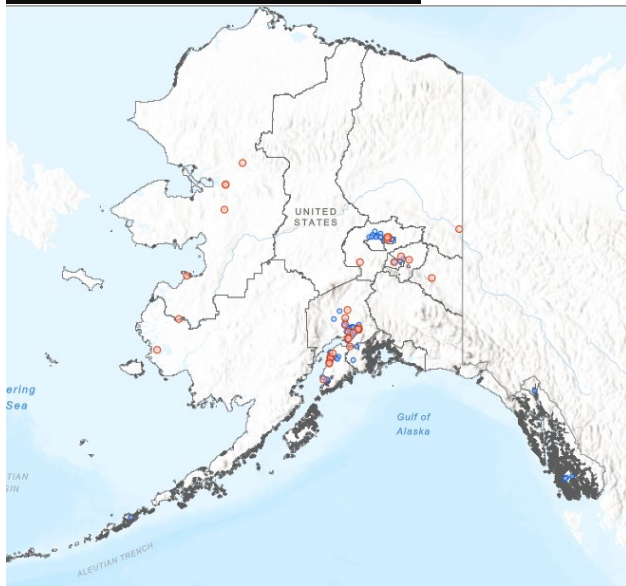
