Significant Issues:

On Saturday June 20, 2026, the SEOC moved to Level 2 – Heightened Awareness given the new ignition of a wildland fires across the state. The most impactful fire is the Starry Fire and currently threatening the community of Anderson in the Denali Borough with evacuation GO orders in place and sheltering available for displaced residents.

As of this morning, firefighters have made progress on the Starry Fire with an established dozer line around the fire perimeter. The fire is currently mapped at approximately 543 acres, with 95 personnel assigned. The evacuation GO order remains in place.

Red Flag Warnings are in effect until 10 pm tonight for much of the central interior with additional thunderstorms and lightning predicted for today. Caution is advised if traveling in the area.

Level 1. READY
Prepare, monitor, and pack your valuables. Create defensible space around your property.

Level 2. SET
Stay informed, review your evacuation plan, and if you need extra time, go now.

Level 3. GO!
EVACUATE NOW

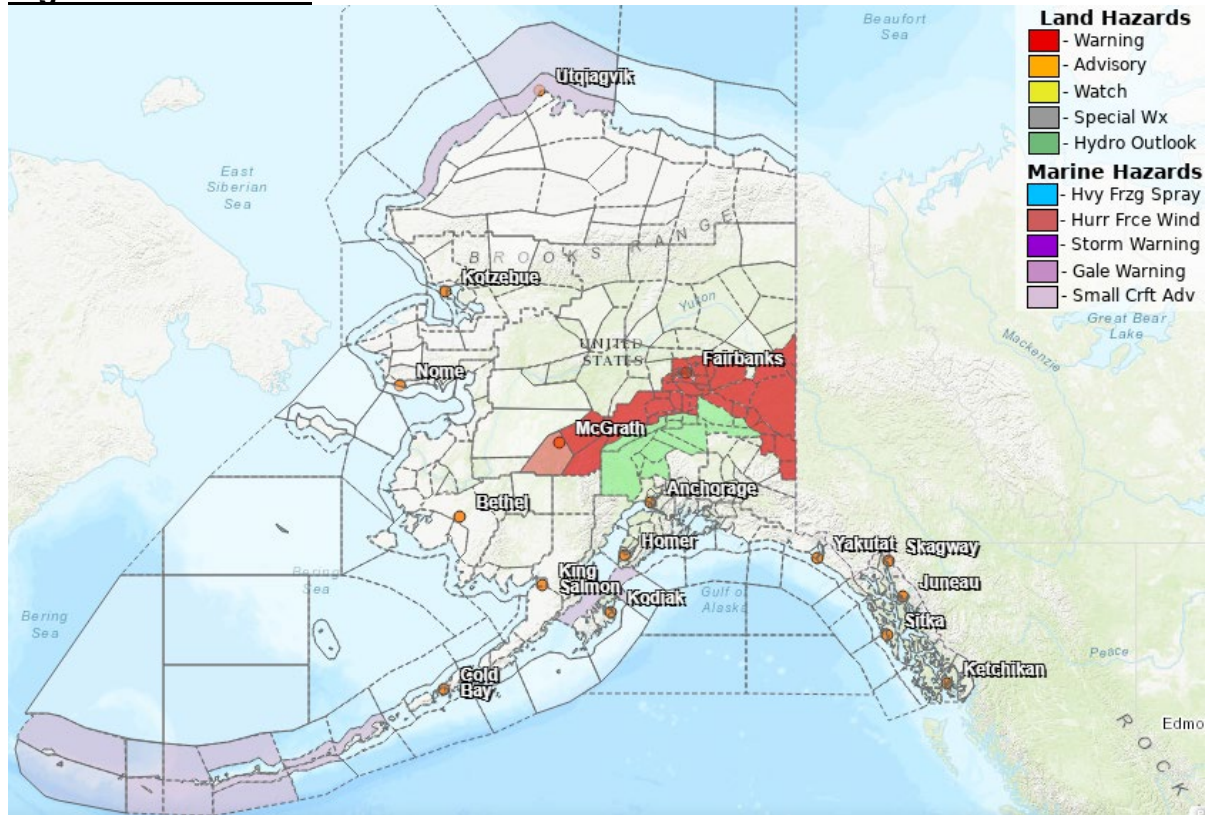

Red Flag Warning:

North Slopes of the Western Alaska Range and Upper Kuskokwim Valley, Southern portions of the Central and Eastern Interior Until 10 PM Monday.

Hydrologic Outlook:

Susitna Valley. Widespread rainfall totaling 1 to 3 inches with the highest totals likely across the northern and western portions of the valley. Expect sharp rises on many small streams and rivers cresting Tuesday night into Wednesday possibly into Thursday.

Hydrologic Outlook:

Northern Denali Borough; Southern Denali Borough; Eastern Alaska Range North of Trims Camp; Eastern Alaska Range South of Trims Camp. Heavy rain possible for the Alaska Range on Tuesday.
