**Significant Issues:**

Tuesday Night at 1922 hours, Duty Officer received a report regarding the restart of a fire near Ambler, with high winds reportedly pushing the fire toward the village. The Northwest Arctic Borough received the information from an Ambler resident and reported it to MATCOM. No additional details were provided at the time of the report. The Duty Officer reported the information to AICC Dispatch for situational awareness.

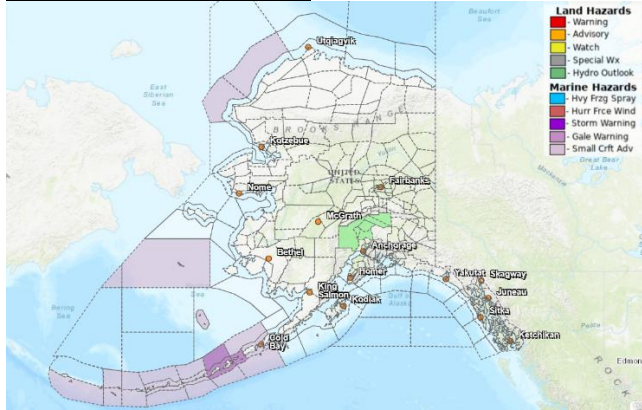
