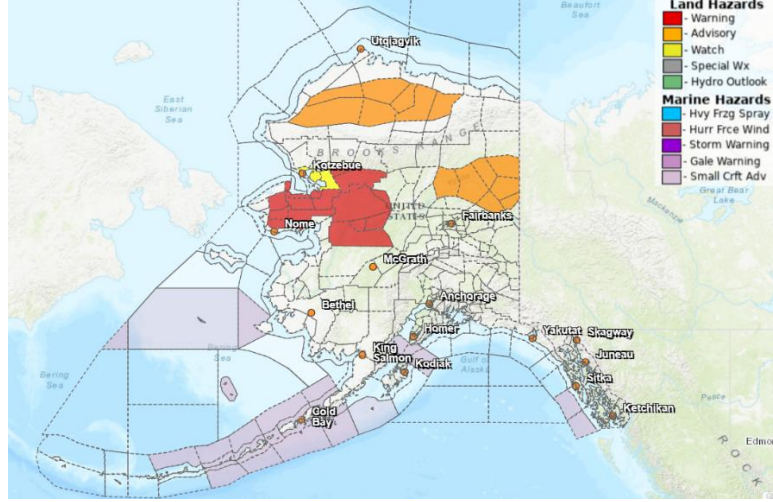

### **WATCHES**

Fire Weather Watch for lightning remains in effect from Wednesday morning through Wednesday evening for the Northern Seward Peninsula, Upper Kobuk Valleys, Lower Koyukuk Valley, and Lower Kobuk Valley.

### **ADVISORIES**

Heat Advisory remains in effect from 10 AM Tuesday to 11 PM Wednesday for the Yukon Flats and for the Western Arctic Plains and Central Arctic Plains.
