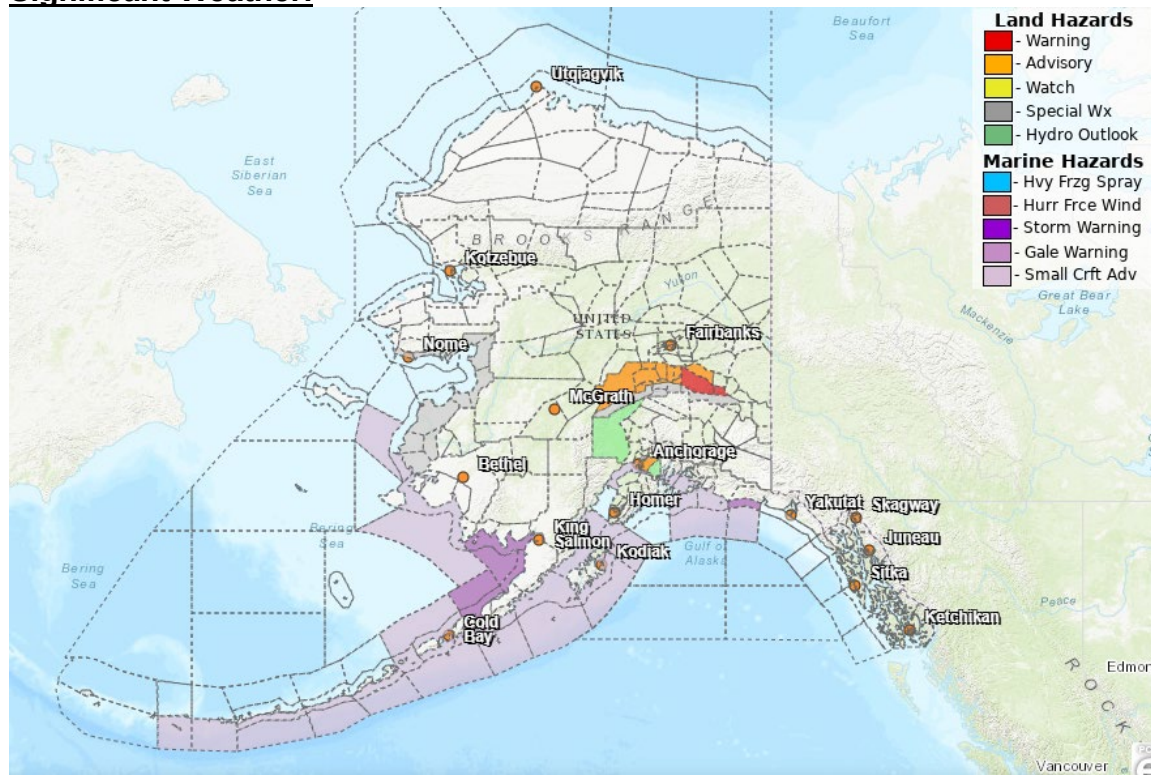

- **Southern Denali Borough; Eastern Alaska Range South of Trims Camp-**Rain and gusty wind this week.
- **Southern Seward Peninsula Coast; Eastern Norton Sound and Nulato Hills; Yukon Delta Coast-**water levels rise 1 to 3 ft this week.

- **Eastern Alaska Range North of Trims Camp-**until 10am Wednesday.

Wind Advisory in effect:

- **Anchorage; Anchorage Hillside / Eagle River-**until 10pm this weekend.
