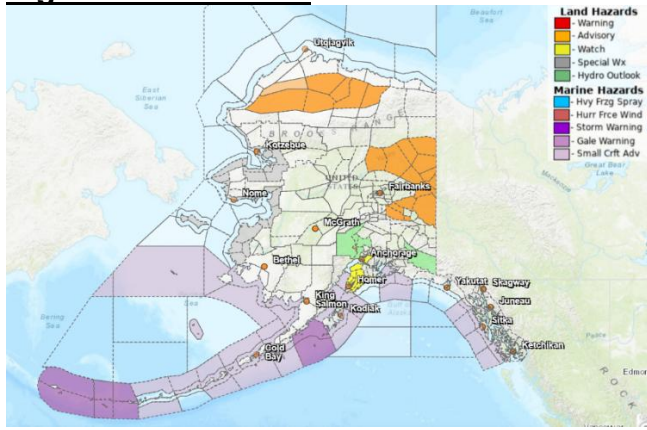

Southern Kenai Mountains: Flood Warning in effect until 10 AM Tuesday.

WATCHES

Southwest Kenai Peninsula, Northwest Kenai Peninsula, and Skilak Lake: Flood Watch in effect through Monday evening.

Anchorage and Anchorage Hillside/Eagle River: Flood Watch in effect from 4 AM Monday through Monday evening.

Southern Kenai Mountains: Flood Watch in effect through Tuesday morning.

ADVISORIES

City of Hyder: Heat Advisory in effect from 1 PM to 7 PM.

Eastern Alaska Range north of Trims Camp and Delta Junction: Wind Advisory in effect until noon Monday.

Yukon Flats and Fortymile Country: Heat Advisory in effect from noon to 10 PM Monday.

Western and Central Arctic Plains: Heat Advisory in effect from 10 AM to 10 PM Monday.

Western Susitna Valley: Flood Advisory in effect until noon Wednesday.

ALERTS

McCarthy: Glacial-dammed lake release may cause significant rises along the Kennicott River near McCarthy.

Western, Southern, and Central Susitna Valley: Significant rainfall through Monday night may bring river rises and localized flooding.

Kivalina and Red Dog Dock, Lower Kobuk Valley, Baldwin Peninsula, Northern Seward Peninsula, Shishmaref, Bering Strait Coast, Southern Seward Peninsula Coast, Eastern Norton Sound and Nulato Hills, Yukon Delta Coast, and St. Lawrence Island: Potential Bering Sea low late this week.
