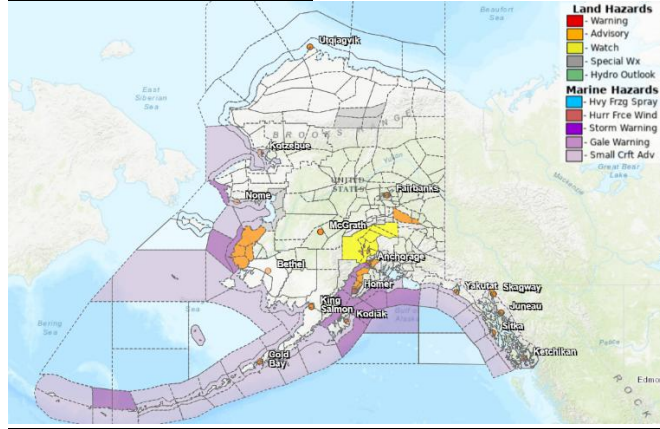

Wind Advisory – Anchorage, Anchorage Hillside, Eagle River, Southwest and Northwest Kenai Peninsula, Eastern Alaska Range north of Trims Camp, and Skagway.
