Significant Issues:

Tok Mukluk Fire

Acres: 7,335

Containment: 29%

Location: Tok, AK

Start Date: Aug. 17, 2026

Fuels: Black Spruce, Shrubs, Grass

Personnel: 110

A Type 3 incident management team assumed command of the Mukluk Fire and continued patrol, monitoring, mop-up, and suppression repair operations. Damage assessments confirmed that 50 residences and 108 secondary structures were destroyed.

EMAC VAL supported donations management and mass care, while Rural Alaska Community Action Program (RurAL CAP) continued assisting the community with the Arctic Shelter mission. Team Rubicon assessed remaining homeowner and community needs and requested 15 volunteers to support debris removal, hazardous tree mitigation, and firewood replacement. Six Alaska National Guard personnel demobilized from Tok and returned to JBER.

DHSEM Operations attended the community meeting to address questions and concerns, while DHSEM Disaster Management continued coordinating with DEC's Solid Waste Program on cleanup support for fire-damaged properties.

Unexploded Ordinance Disposal:

Last night, SEOC received notice of a suspicious item found north of Haines. SEOC coordinated response with the FBI for follow-up and disposal.

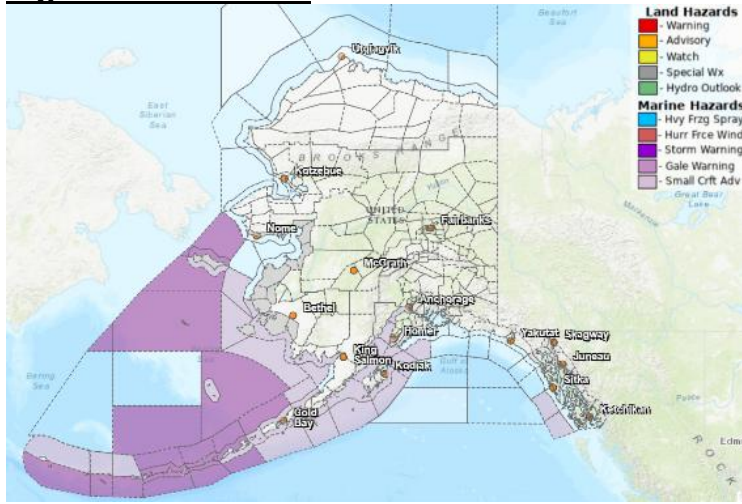
