Acres: 7,339

Containment: 45%

The fire has been turned back to the local area and will remain in monitor status. Local area resources will continue to monitor for hazards. Team Rubicon demobilized.

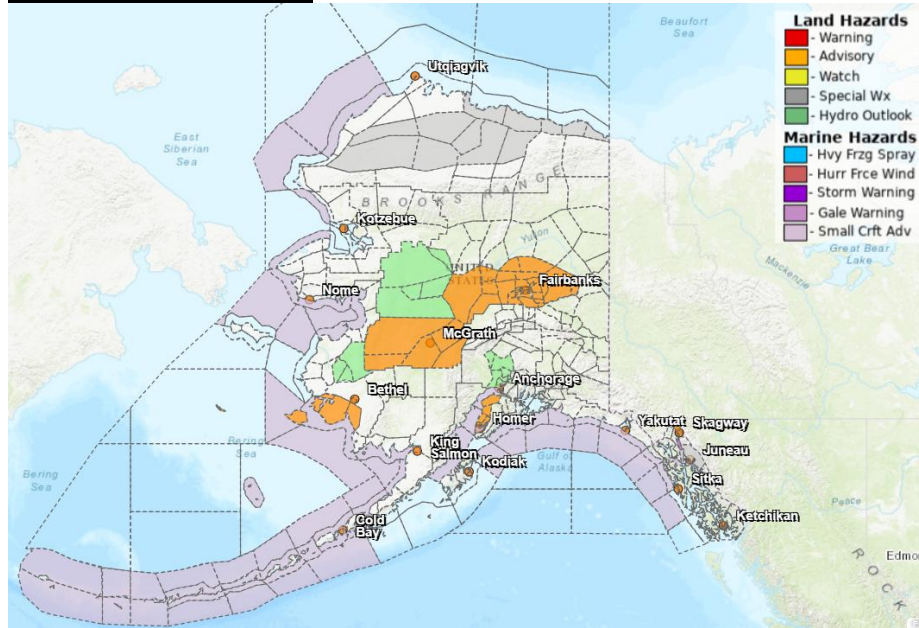

Wind Advisory:

Anchorage; SW Kenai Peninsula; NW Kenai Peninsula – until noon today. Municipality of Skagway – until 7 PM this evening. Central Interior – until 10 PM Wednesday. White Mountains and High Terrain South of the Yukon River; Upper Chena River Valley; Tanana Flats; Eielson AFB and Salcha; Goldstream Valley and Nenana Hills; Chatanika River Valley; Two Rivers; Fairbanks Metro Area; Nenana – from 4 AM Wednesday to 4 AM Thursday. Lower Yukon and Innoko Valleys; North Slopes of the Western Alaska Range; Upper Kuskokwim Valley – until 4 PM Wednesday.

Flood Advisory:

Interior Kuskokwim Delta – until 1 PM this afternoon.

Coastal Flood Advisory: Kuskokwim Delta Coast and Nunivak Island – until 10 AM this morning.

Flood Watch:

Two Rivers; Fairbanks Metro Area – through Saturday afternoon. Upper Kuskokwim Valley – through Friday afternoon.

Hydrologic Outlook:

Lower Matanuska Valley; Hatcher Pass; Southern Susitna Valley; Central Susitna Valley – significant rainfall through tomorrow afternoon for the Matanuska and Susitna Valleys. Lower Yukon River; Lower Koyukuk Valley; Middle Yukon Valley; Lower Yukon and Innoko Valleys – through Thursday afternoon for heavy rain and rising rivers.

Special Weather Statement:

City and Borough of Juneau – Suicide Basin slowly rising. Central Beaufort Sea Coast; Eastern Beaufort Sea Coast; Western Arctic Plains; Central Arctic Plains – pockets of freezing rain and freezing drizzle possible Tuesday night through Wednesday morning.
