Significant Issues:

Holy Cross

SEOC received notification regarding impacts to the Holy Cross Post Office, which has been closed for approximately 2–3 weeks due to mold associated with spring flooding. SEOC is in contact with community members and the U.S. Postal Service. The information was also shared with Disaster Assistance.

West Coast Storm

SEOC participated in a National Weather Service briefing regarding updates on the approaching storm system. A joint weather conference with the Anchorage and Fairbanks NWS offices is anticipated tomorrow. According to NOAA, Ex-Dujuan is not expected to be as impactful as Ex-Halong due to several notable meteorological differences between the systems.

Tok Wildland Fire

The joint Preliminary Damage Assessment (PDA) with FEMA remains ongoing this week. Individual Assistance (IA) and SBA teams are in Tok, while Public Assistance (PA) assessments are being conducted virtually. 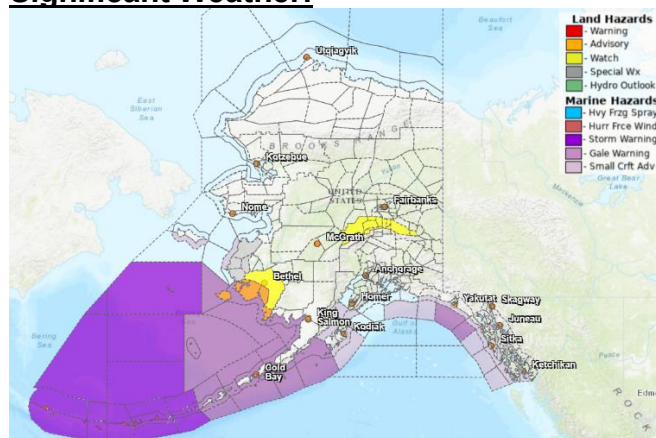

Shemya and Attu Islands – from 10 PM this evening to 10 AM Thursday. Atka and Adak – from 7 AM to 10 PM Thursday.

Wind Advisory:

Kuskokwim Delta Coast and Nunivak Island; Western Capes – from 7 AM Thursday to 1 AM Friday.

High Wind Watch:

Northern Denali Borough; Eastern Alaska Range North of Trims Camp – from Thursday evening through Saturday evening.

Flood Watch:

Interior Kuskokwim Delta – through Saturday afternoon.
