Alaska Wildland 2024 Fire Season Evacuation Status:

Globe Fire #253 (Grapefruit Complex):

- Go- **Red**: Elliott Highway Milepost 30-50
- Set- **Yellow**: Elliott Highway Milepost 50-60
- Ready- **Green**: Elliott Highway Milepost 18-30 and 60-70

Riley Creek Fire #318 (Denali):

- Go- **Red**: All Bison Gulch and Antler Ridge Hikers. All employees housed at Denali National Park Joint Venture Facility
- Set- **Yellow**: Riley Creek Campground, Denali National Park Headquarters and C-Camp
- Ready- **Green**: Nenana Canyon Area (aka Glitter Gulch)

Shelter: Red Cross reports that 50 people sheltered overnight at Tri Valley High School in Healy.

Montana Creek Fire #312 (Mat-Su Valley):

- Go- **Red**: None
- Set- **Yellow**: Residences on Leroy Davie and Riddle Ave subdivisions
- Ready- **Green**: None

Fairbanks North Star Borough:

- Go- **Red**: None
- Set- **Yellow**: Cabins in Tanana South area
- Ready- **Green**: Areas along the Salcha River, Harding Lake, Hollies Acres, Canaday, Salcha and Johnson Road neighborhoods.

Stebbins School Fire:

The SEOC continues to be actively engaged with Stebbins in their recovery from the fire. Disaster Assistance is implementing Governor Dunleavy's disaster declaration for public assistance.

Space Object Re-entry Concern:

The SEOC received notice over the weekend that a 10.83 meters squared object was expected to reenter the earth's atmosphere over the state of Alaska. Staff engaged to respond. Object ultimately reentered over the Pacific Ocean and was deemed not a threat to the state.

State of Alaska Department of Health (DOH):

The DOH stands ready to assist with all aspects of public health and, in the event of a public health emergency, is supported by the SEOC and other state departments as required.

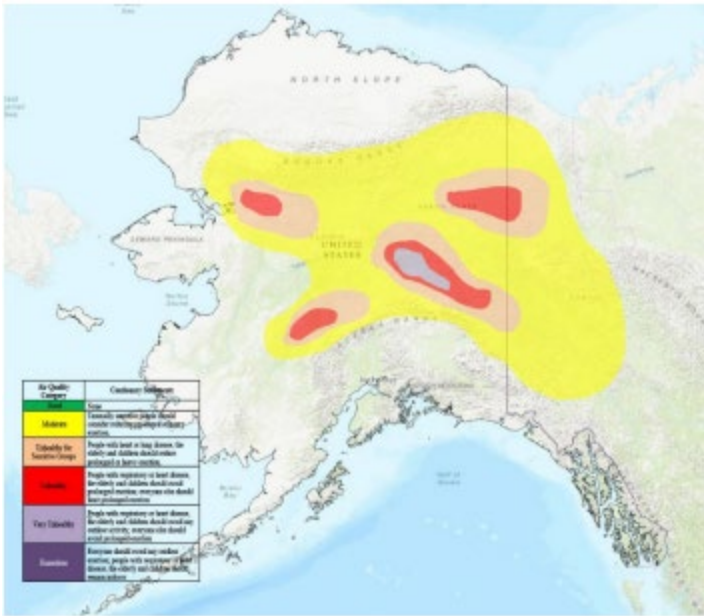

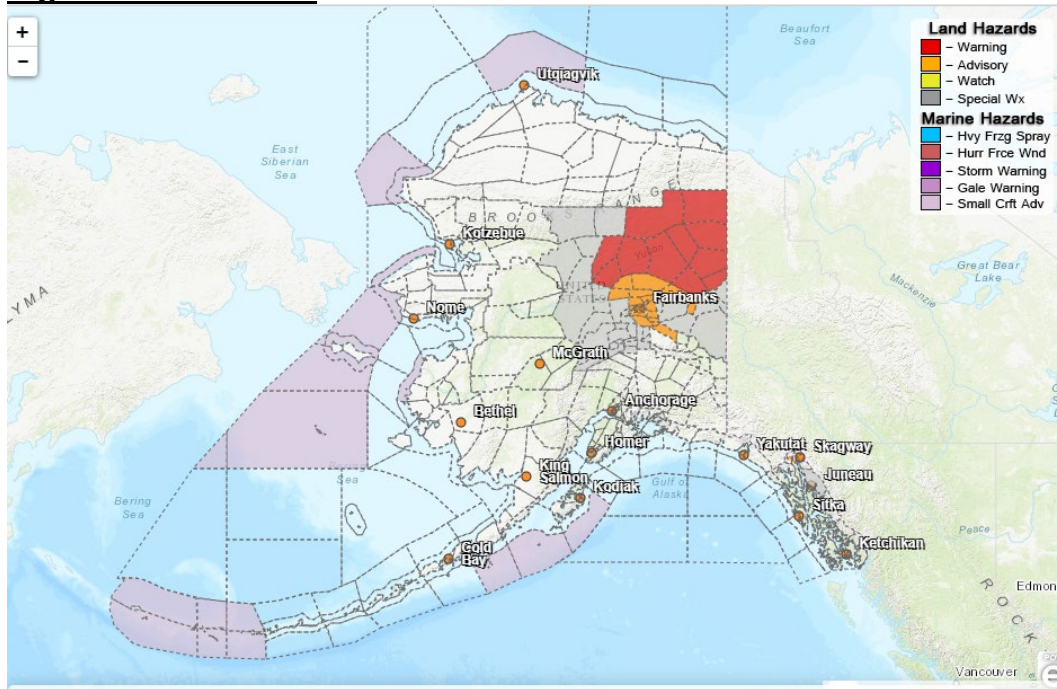

Significant Weather:



Red Flag Warning:

South Slopes of the Eastern Brooks Range, Dalton Highway Summits, Yukon Flats from 2pm to 10pm Tuesday.

Dense Smoke Advisory:

White Mountains and High Terrain South of the Yukon River; Tanana Flats; Eielson AFB and Salcha; Goldstream Valley and Nenana Hills; Chatanika River Valley; Two Rivers; Fairbanks Metro Area; Nenana – until noon on Monday.

Flood Advisory:

Haines Borough and Klukwan – remains in effect until 7pm Tuesday for snowmelt.

Special Weather Statement:

Major weather pattern shift expected Tuesday through late week for the Interior. Area will be see increasing winds up to 20mph with gusts up to 30mph. Chances for rain begin Wednesday and will continue through the weekend.

Hydrologic Outlook:

City and Borough of Juneau – A glacial dam release has begun this evening on the Taku River. Water level is expected to continue to rise into early week.
