Significant Issues:

Klondike Highway Rockslide:

Skagway Police Department issued a notice that the South Klondike Highway Road between KM 106 and 24 will remain closed due to a rock and mudslide that occurred yesterday morning. The local Public Works department has begun clearing the road and is aiming to open a single lane for traffic on Friday. The next update is expected to be provided this afternoon.

Sinnott Wildland Fires:

SEOC contacted the BLM for the status on the Sinnott Wildland Fire. BLM reports a wildland fire module is being sent from the Kenai Peninsula to support the City of Eagle for this fire.
