Significant Issues:

2025 Riverwatch Operations:

No flooding to date, flood risk is at a low as of today. SEOC teams are still flying out of Fairbanks and Bethel today. Another team will be flying into Galena on Wednesday and Thursday of this week to fly over the Middle Yukon. Even though a particular river or reach may be described as mostly open or open, it is still possible for runs of ice and debris to move through as headwaters upstream break up. Please use caution at all times when attempting to navigate rivers.

Ketchikan North Tongass Hwy at Wolfe Point: Expect delays due to rock scaling operations and blasting efforts.

Bridge preservation work on the Glenn Highway will cause delays near the Knik River as crews rehabilitate three bridge decks. The northbound Knik River Bridge is closed until late May, with all traffic shifted onto the southbound bridge; expect congestion, speed reductions, and follow all posted detours.




