### **Significant Issues:**

#### **St. Michael Frozen Line**

DEC reported to the SEOC that operators in St. Michael successfully jettied the discharge line and service has been restored. SEOC will continue to monitor this event for impacts.

#### **Pavlov Volcano Alert Change:**

Alaska Volcano Observatory notified the SEOC that they have changed the alert level of Pavlov from Advisory/Yellow to Normal/Green. This will be removed from reporting.

#### **2025 October West Coast Storm Disaster:**

- 69 households/203 individuals transitioned from non-congregate shelters (hotels) to longer-term housing (apartments)

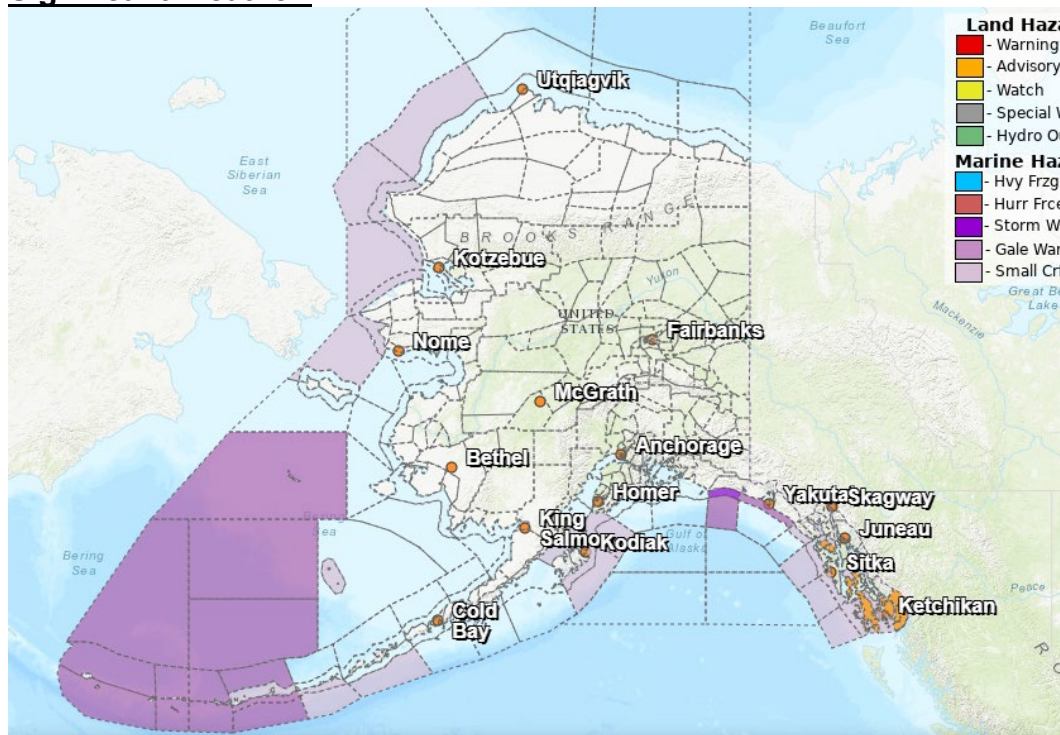

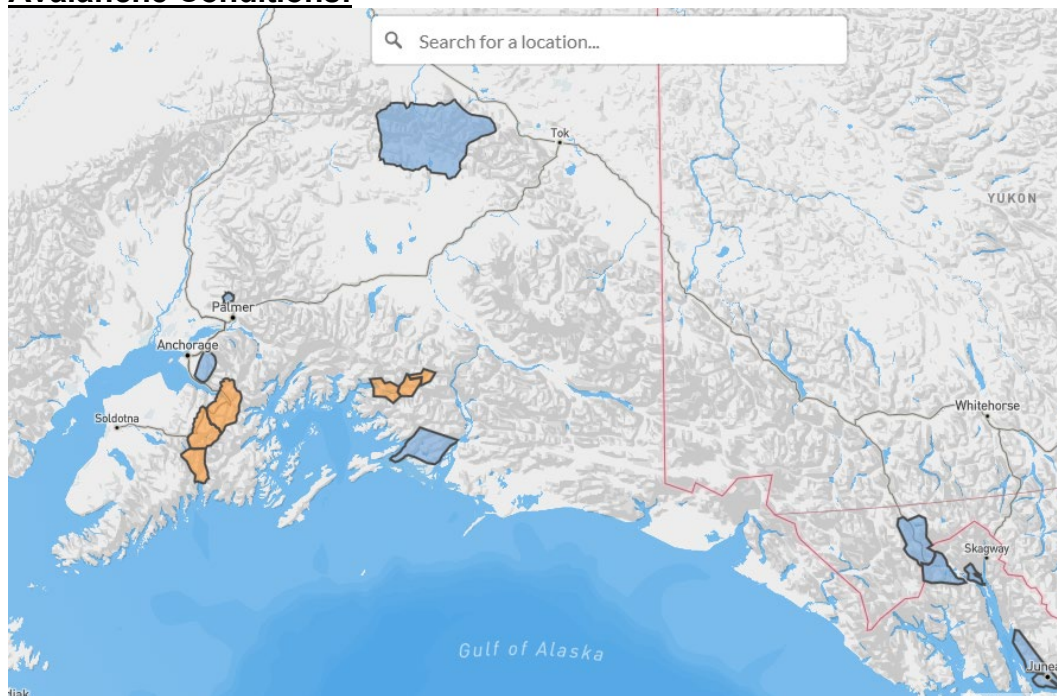

**Turnagain Pass and Girdwood** – Considerable at elevations above 1000ft, Moderate below 1000ft

**Summit Lake** - Considerable at elevations above 1000ft, Moderate below 1000ft

**Seward and Lost Lake**- Considerable at elevations above 1000ft, Moderate below 1000ft

**Maritime** – Considerable at elevations from 1500 to 3000ft, Moderate at above 3000ft

**Intermountain** – Considerable at elevations between 2000 to 4000ft, Moderate above 4000ft

**Continental** – Considerable at elevations above 2000ft
