## **Significant Issues:**

### **USGS-Alaska Volcano Observatory (AVO):**

SEOC participated in a communication collaboration with AVO, the JBER EOC, Volcano Notification Service (VNS) representatives and the 611<sup>th</sup> to help evaluate USGS information products.

### **Shungnak Declaration:**

Late this afternoon, the SEOC received a local declaration from the community of Shungnak as well as the Northwest Arctic Borough. The community is experiencing issues with their water due to frozen pipes. There are workers on site starting the process of thawing. DEC and Mass Care have been notified. SEOC stands ready to support.

### **2025 October West Coast Storm Disaster:**

- 108 households/340 individuals transitioned from non-congregate shelters (hotels) to longer-term housing (apartments)

### **Barry Arm Landslide / Tsunami Risk:**

The Barry Arm landslide currently shows no signs of large-scale active deformation but smaller-scale instabilities on the surface of the landslide still pose a threat of localized tsunami generation in Barry Arm. Mariners transiting near Barry Arm should remain vigilant.

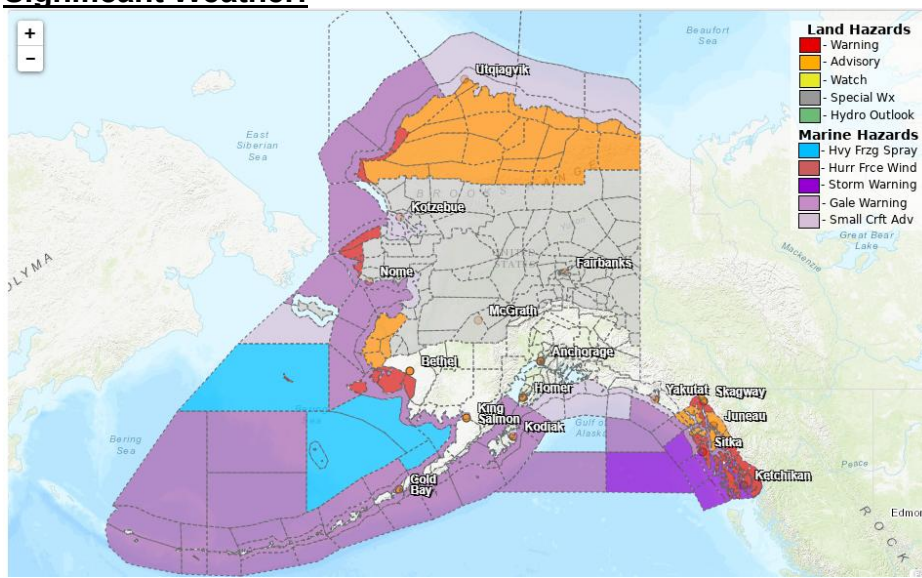

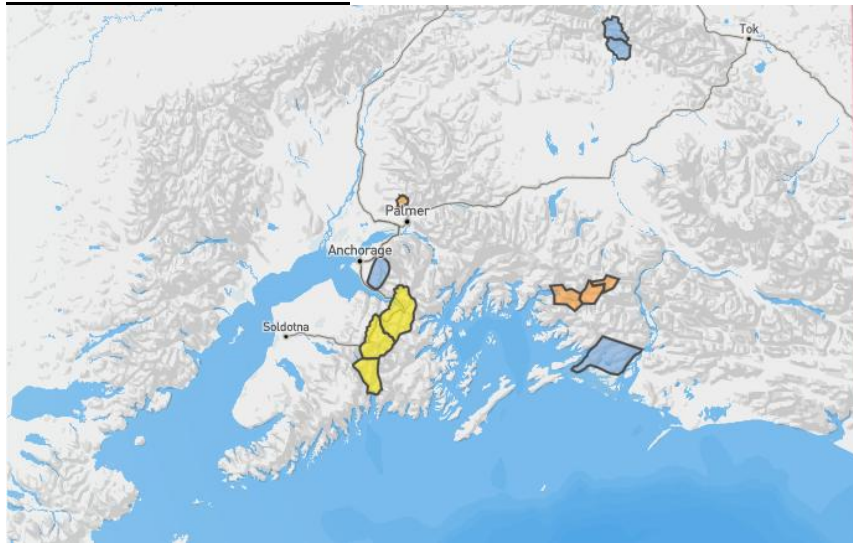
