**Significant Issues:**

**Port Alsworth Power Outage:**

A lineman and specialized equipment arrived yesterday to assist crews in setting up a temporary above-ground line, allowing sections of the system to be isolated and the fault to be identified. Once located, the plan is to bypass the fault to restore full service while permanent repairs are arranged. Crews paused troubleshooting overnight to prevent potential additional damage, and the system remained stable. Work will resume this morning with improved daylight and conditions. Replacement transformer fuses are expected by late morning so they are available if needed during diagnostics. Partial power remains available in the community. SEOC will remain engaged over the holiday weekend to monitor the event and support if needed.

**State Declaration for the Northwest Arctic Borough:**

SEOC continues to support the Borough as thawing efforts continue in impacted communities. Disaster Assistance has begun to implement the Public Assistance programs pursuant to the Governor's declaration of disaster.

**2025 October West Coast Storm Disaster:**

147 households/ 509 individuals transitioned from non-congregate shelters (hotels) to longer-term housing (apartments)






Winter Weather Advisory is in effect for Prince of Wales Island, Ketchikan Gateway Borough and Annette Island until 10am Saturday.

**Summit Lake – Moderate above 2500' low below 2500'.**

**Seward and Lost Lake – Low at all elevations.**

**Maritime, Intermountain, Continental – Moderate at all levels.**

**Haines area/Chiklat Pass – Considerable above treeline.**

**Douglas Island – Moderate at all elevations.**
