Significant Issues:

The Grandview fire was reported yesterday late afternoon near Swanson River Road in Sterling with initial estimates of 5-10 acres at 5:30 PM. The Division of Forestry & Fire Protection responded with significant resources immediately including mobilizing support from Palmer and Fairbanks. The fire is currently estimated at 90 acres with teams having worked late into the evening strengthening and securing containment lines. Information will be updated on Alaska Wildland Fire Information as it becomes available.

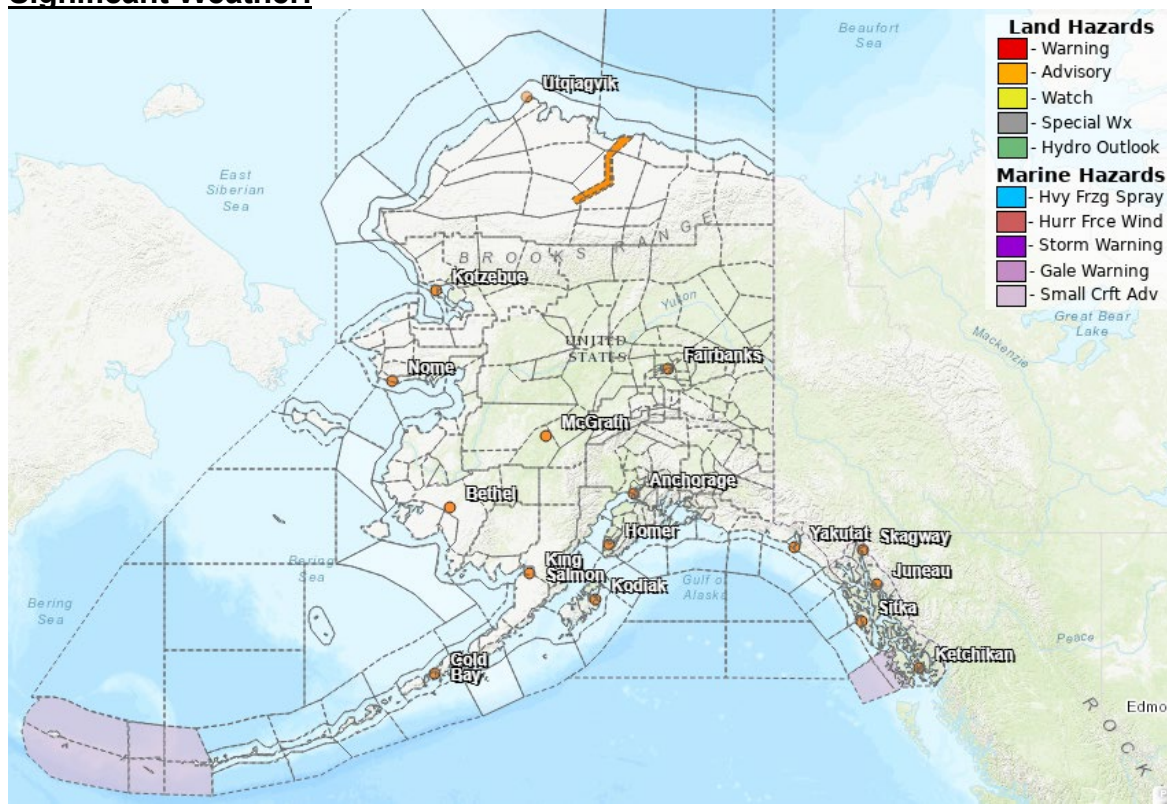
