**Significant Issues:**

Statewide wildland fire activity remains at Planning Level 3 of 5, with 13 staffed fires and 441 personnel assigned. A Red Flag Warning is in effect for the Upper Kobuk and Lower Koyukuk Valleys. While much of the state is experiencing cooler and wetter conditions, the northwest region remains under critical fire weather conditions, with thousands of lightning strikes expected this afternoon and tomorrow.

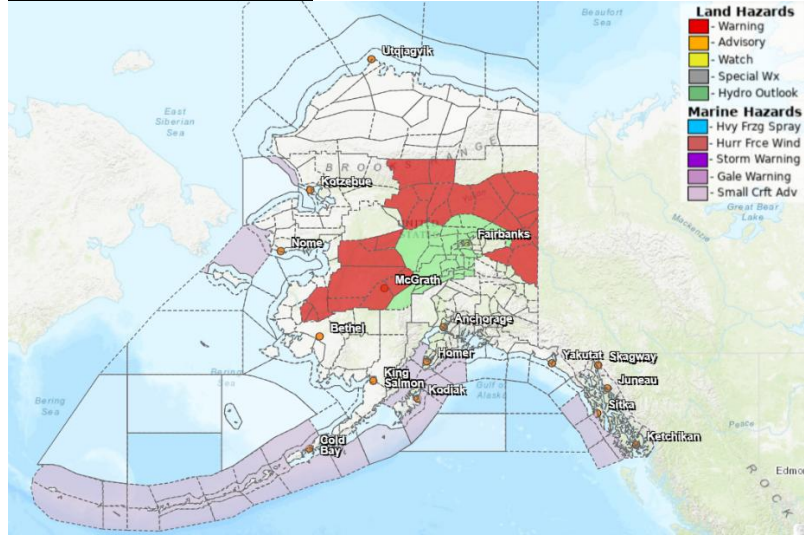

Red Flag Warning for lightning remains in effect for the Yukon Flats, Fortymile Country, South Slopes of the Central Brooks Range, Upper Koyukuk Valley, and Dalton Highway Summits from 1 PM Friday afternoon to 12 AM Saturday.

## ADVISORIES

Hydrologic Outlook remains in effect through Monday for the White Mountains and high terrain south of the Yukon River, Tanana Flats, Goldstream Valley and Nenana Hills, Chatanika River Valley, Fairbanks Metro Area, Nenana, Central Interior, Northern Denali Borough, Southern Denali Borough, North Slopes of the Western Alaska Range, and Upper Kuskokwim Valley.
