**Significant Issues:** Red Flag Warning and Fire Weather for Western Alaska.

MatCom reported that several pull-type explosive devices were found at a private residence in Wasilla. Airforce Explosive Ordnance Disposal specialist was contacted to assist with safe removal. EOD responded to the residence with support from the Wasilla Police Department and removed the items without further incident.

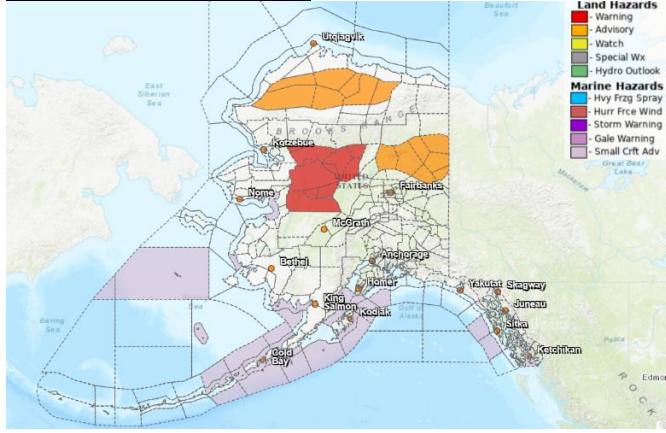
