Significant Issues:

SEOC participated in a National Weather Service briefing regarding updates on the approaching storm. SEOC remains in communication with ANTHC and contacted communities located within warning areas to provide updated information. An SEOC training specialist currently in Bethel is available to relay information and provide real-time updates as needed. According to NOAA, Ex-Dujuan is not expected to be as impactful as Ex-Halong due to several notable meteorological differences between the two systems.

Juneau – Mendenhall GLOF

Suicide Basin has begun refilling. Based on current conditions, a full release would result in minor flood-stage impacts.

Tok Wildland Fire

The joint Preliminary Damage Assessment (PDA) with FEMA remains ongoing this week. Individual Assistance (IA) and SBA teams are currently in Tok, while Public Assistance (PA) assessments are being conducted virtually. IA and SBA personnel plan to demobilize and return tomorrow.

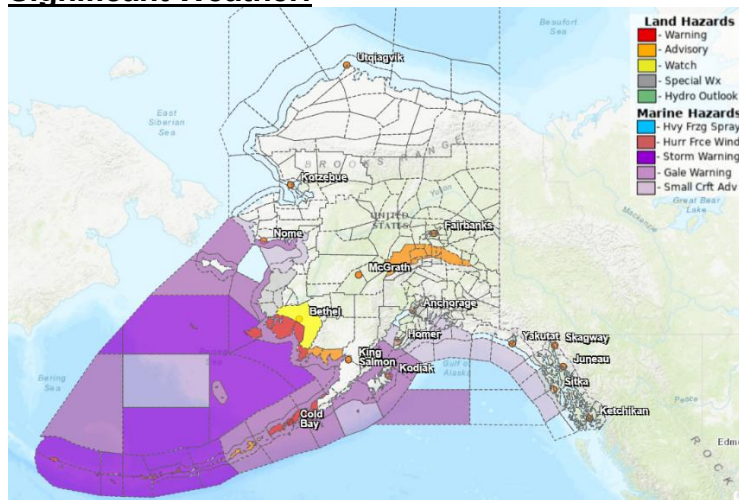

Coastal Flood Warning:

Kuskokwim Delta Coast and Nunivak Island – until 4 AM Saturday.

High Wind Warning: Aleutians East Borough – until 11 AM this morning. Atka and Adak – until 10 PM this evening. Shemya and Attu Islands – until 10 AM this morning. Kuskokwim Delta Coast and Nunivak Island; Western Capes – until 1 AM Friday.

Wind Advisory:

Northern Bristol Bay Coast – until 10 PM this evening. Unalaska and Nikolski – from 7 PM this evening to 10 PM Friday. Northern Denali Borough – from midnight tonight to 4 AM Sunday. Eastern Alaska Range North of Trims Camp – from 10 PM this evening to 7 AM Sunday.

Flood Watch: Interior Kuskokwim Delta – through Saturday afternoon.

Special Weather Statement:

Yukon Delta Coast – minor water level rises and gusty winds in Hooper Bay. Aleutians East Borough – strong southerly winds along the Alaska Peninsula this morning. Anchorage; Anchorage Hillside / Eagle River; Lower Matanuska Valley – strong winds along Turnagain Arm, the Anchorage Hillside, and Knik River Valley tonight through Saturday.
