Significant Issues:

SEOC Preparedness Level 2 - Heightened Awareness: Tok Wildland fire.
AICC Preparedness Level: 2

The Governor has verbally declared a state disaster emergency for the Alaska Gateway REAA, including Tok, as a result of the Mukluk Fire. The declaration authorizes both Public Assistance and Individual Assistance. FEMA has also approved a Fire Management Assistance Grant declaration, which reimburses the State for eligible fire suppression costs.

A Type 3 Incident Management Team has been ordered and is en route to Tok to assist with coordination of the response.

SEOC deployed a Division Supervisor to the Tok area to support the community and Tanana Chiefs Conference response efforts.

The American Red Cross (ARC) sent personnel to assist with establishing a shelter last night. The ARC trailer and additional staff are expected to arrive today.

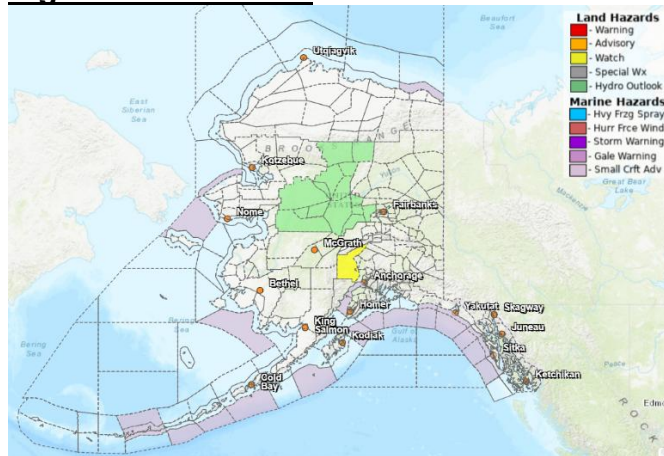
