## **Significant Issues:**

## Thanksgiving Day Southcentral Earthquake

- At 0812 hrs. on Thanksgiving Day, November 27, 2025, SEOC recorded a Magnitude 6.0 Earthquake 35 miles NW of Anchorage and 26 miles SW of Willow.
- SEOC executed the earthquake checklist and checked with communities within 100 miles of the epicenter. No significant damage was reported.
- SEOC also contacted the Alaska Earthquake Center Duty Seismologist who verified preliminary magnitude 6.0, NW of Anchorage and W of Big Lake, very widely felt, depth of 40 miles and no significant damage reported. Multiple aftershocks were reported, with the largest in the 3.2 range.

## Typhoon Halong: 2025 October West Coast Storm Disaster

Recovery operations continue in a Unified Coordination Group with FEMA at a joint Field Office in Anchorage, with Branch operations in Bethel.


